Subject: Resolution Ratifying the Submission of a Grant Application to the Florida Inland Navigation District, Waterways Assistance Program for up to \$500,000 in Grant Funds to Construct Three (3) Sections of the Miami River Greenway

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached resolution ratifying the submission of a grant application to the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND), Waterways Assistance Program for up to \$500,000 in grant funds for the construction of three (3) sections of the Miami River Greenway, and further authorizing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to receive and expend funds and execute contracts and amendments as required.

SCOPE

These sections of the Miami River Greenway are located at sites on the Miami River's South Shore at the SE 5 Street Metromover Station, the South Shore beneath SW 2 Avenue Bridge, and the North Shore beneath the South Miami Avenue Bridge. All sites are located within the City of Miami, in Commission District 5. The Miami River Greenway will provide public access to the Miami River for all residents and visitors to Miami-Dade County.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

The total construction cost of the project is \$1,165,463. The grant match of \$665,463 will be provided by future bond funding from the Building Better Communities General Obligation Bond Program (BBC-GOB). The tentative date for the next BBC-GOB bond sale is August 2012.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

The grant will be administered by Miami-Dade County Public Works Department (PWD). The Project Manager responsible for monitoring project construction for the County is Bassam Moubayed, CFM, Chief, Construction Division, PWD.

BACKGROUND

On November 2, 2004, voters approved the BBC-GOB and associated capital improvement projects throughout the County. The list of projects includes Project No. 126 – "Miami River Greenway." The project consists of construction at six (6) separate County-owned parcels which will provide continuity to the Miami River Greenway Network.

This application is being submitted to provide funding for Miami River Greenway Sites 1, 2, and 3. These are located on the Miami River's South Shore at the SE 5 Street Metromover Station, the South Shore beneath SW 2 Avenue Bridge, and the North Shore beneath South Miami Avenue Bridge. Project items will include the construction of a 25'-0" wide pedestrian/bicycle shared use riverwalk with

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decorative lighting, landscaping, wayfinding signage, bicycle racks, pet stations, benches and trash receptacles.

FIND is a Special State Taxing District for the continued management and maintenance of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway. The Waterways Assistance Program is a grant program established by the Florida Legislature and the District for the purpose of financially cooperating with local governments to alleviate problems associated with the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway (ICW) and associated waterways within the District. The Miami River Greenway is located along a Federal Navigable Channel, which directly connects to the ICW. FIND required the submission of this application by April 1, 2011. This special resolution must be approved by June 1, 2011. If the application is successful, grant funds will be available in October 2011.

The project is tentatively scheduled to begin construction in August 2012, and is anticipated to be completed by the end of February 2013.

RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT, WATERWAYS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR UP TO \$500,000 IN GRANT FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT THREE (3) SECTIONS OF THE MIAMI RIVER GREENWAY AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND FUNDS, AND TO EXECERCISE ALL PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is interested in carrying out the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida:

Project Title: Miami River Greenways

Total Estimated Cost: \$1,165,463

Brief Description of Project: Construction of three (3) sections of the Miami River Greenway, separate County-owned parcels which will provide continuity to the Miami River Greenway Network. The project includes the construction of a 25'-0" wide pedestrian/bicycle shared use riverwalk including lighting, landscaping, and hardscape elements such as benches and trash receptacles, seawall construction, drainage, landscape architecture details, and all of the necessary incidental items for a complete project; and

WHEREAS, Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) financial assistance is required for the program mentioned above,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board ratifies the submission of a Grant Application to the FIND Waterways Assistance Program to apply for up to \$500,000 in grant funds from FIND for the construction of sections of the Miami River Greenway and that the project described above be authorized;

AND, be it further resolved that said Miami-Dade County makes application to the FIND in the amount of 43% of the actual cost of the project in behalf of said Miami-Dade County;

AND, be it further resolved by Miami-Dade County that it certifies to the following:

1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in FIND Rule 66B-2 F.A.C. and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any assistance awarded under the attached proposal.
2. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the Program in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the District.
3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Miami-Dade County for public use.
4. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P. L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with statutes relating to accessibility by handicapped persons as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.

5. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.

6. That it will make available to FIND if requested, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.

AND, be it resolved that the Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute such contracts and agreements as are required by this governmental body following approval by the County Attorney's Office; to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request; and to file and execute any necessary amendments to the agreement for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.


