DAYS, OUTLINING THE BEST METHODOLOGY AND
IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE TO CREATE A VIRTUAL
OR PHYSICAL ONE-STOP INFORMATION CENTER FOR
OPENING A NEW BUSINESS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, small businesses in the United States are an integral component of the economy, and represent 99.7 percent of all employer firms; and

WHEREAS, the high unemployment rate in Miami-Dade County (the "County"), magnifies the importance to help business creation; and

WHEREAS, the creation of either a website based virtual, or physically located one-stop information center, whereby County residents can inquire about and receive information on the requirements to open a new business in the County, should stimulate small business development,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor or his designee is directed to prepare a report outlining the best methodology and implementation schedule to create a virtual or physical one-stop information center for opening a new business in Miami-Dade County. The results of the report shall be presented to this Board of County Commissioners within sixty (60) days of the date of this resolution.
