Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$526,320.48 between Florida Engineering and Development Corp. and Miami-Dade County for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Project Entitled Roadway Improvements along Caribbean Boulevard, from SW 110 Court to Busway, located within Commission District 9 (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20100669) and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the PTP Roadway Improvements along Caribbean Boulevard, from SW 110 Court to Busway, located within Commission District 9, in the amount of \$526,320.48, between Florida Engineering and Development Corp. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. Proceeds from a Charter County Transportation System Sales Surtax Bond Sale will be used to fund this project; therefore, approval by the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) and Board of County Commissioners (BCC) is required.

Scope

The work to be performed under the life of this contract includes roadway improvements along Caribbean Boulevard, from SW 110 Court to Busway, located within Commission District 9.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$526,320.48 and will be funded from Charter County Transportation Surtax 2010 Bond Proceeds. The funding index code for this project is CPEPTP409RWD.99021, as programmed within the adopted FY 2010-11 Capital Budget. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. The base contract amount is \$442,429.00, but the total allocated amount is \$526,320.48, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances. The estimated maintenance cost is \$3,605.80 and the estimated operational cost is \$2,994.92 and will be funded through the Department's General Funds. Due to the removal of the existing nine (9) light poles and the installation of three (3) new decorative lighting poles, there is an estimated operational cost savings of \$789.83.

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this contract.

Track Record/Monitor

The contractor, Florida Engineering and Development Corp. has not performed any work for Miami-Dade County. However, PWD staff contacted the City of North Miami Beach and based on several roadway and drainage improvement projects, their overall performance level was rated satisfactory and overall the firm is highly recommended.

Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. Frank Aira, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Joaquin Rabassa, P.E., Project Coordinator, for day to day responsibilities.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Florida Engineering and Development Corp., Company Principals are: Jose Vega, Elina Reyes and Omar A. Medina and the Company's address is listed as: 12076 NW 98 Avenue, Hialeah Gardens, Florida 33018.


Background

In an effort to carry on the success of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under the MCC 7360 Program. Through this process, PWD forwards the RPQ, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of firms that have registered with OCI for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest sum bid submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWD staff submitted the referenced project to the Department of Small Business Development's Review Committee. The Review Committee met on September 29, 2010 reviewed RPQ No. 20100669 and recommended a 20% overall Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) subcontractor goal based on the project's scope of work and cost estimate of \$722,494.60 and also recommended a 12.60% Community Workforce Program Goal. Therefore, on January 13, 2011, PWD forwarded an RPQ for the PTP Roadway Improvements to Caribbean Boulevard, from SW 110 Court to Busway, utilizing the OCI contract MCC 7360 Plan, to a list of 55 pre-registered firms. A total of 18 firms purchased contract documents and 13 firms proffered a bid.

On February 14, 2011, Florida Engineering and Development Corp. proffered the lowest responsive, responsible base bid of \$442,429.00, 28% below the County's cost estimate; the second lowest bidder, Quality Construction Performance, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$477,882.15, 6% over the lowest bidder; the third lowest bidder, Williams Paving Co., Inc. proffered a base bid of \$489,632.50, 2% over the second lowest bidder. Florida Engineering and Development Corp. submitted the required Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing to utilize the following CSBE firms: A. Bernal Services Corp., to perform electrical – traffic signals and street lighting work at 9.5%; P & J Striping, Inc., to perform striping, thermo, and signs work at 1.8%; and Barreiro Construction Corp., to perform concrete flat work at 12.8%. Florida Engineering fulfilled the 20% contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE participation provisions. As a result, on March 25, 2011, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ No. 20100669 to Florida Engineering and Development Corp., with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC due to guidelines associated with the funding source.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor (including cleaning and preparation), required materials, equipment and tools to perform all operations necessary for reconstructing the existing four lane roadway to proper lane widths, install drainage curb and gutters, pedestrian ramps, signalization, pavement markings, signage and decorative roadway lighting.

This letter will serve as your notification that you have been recommended for award for the above referenced RPQ based on your Price Quotation submitted on Monday, February 14, 2011. The total RPQ amount is for five hundred twenty-six thousand three hundred twenty dollars and forty-eight cents (\$526,320.48). This includes a base contract amount of four hundred forty-two thousand four hundred twenty-nine dollars and zero cents (\$442,429.00), a contingency amount of forty-four thousand two hundred forty-two dollars and ninety cents (\$44,242.90), and dedicated allowances totaling thirty-nine thousand six hundred forty-eight dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$39,648.58). The contract duration is established as **150-calendar days**. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required in Contract No. MCC 7360 Plan, Section 2.0 Special Conditions, Page 16, Article 2.11, **PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**. (The **original attached documents** must be used and three (3) sets must be provided).

The preceding documents are required as outlined within Contract MCC 7360 Plan and to be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the document(s) within the specified time, or any extension granted, will result in the award being rescinded.


