This item, listed as Agenda Item 3K on the April 13, 2011 Infrastructure and Land Use Committee was amended by the Committee as follows:

The Committee agreed that the proposals received in response to OCI Project No. A09-OCI-01, A should be rejected. However, the Committee amended the item to instruct the Mayor or Mayor's designee to appropriately survey County departments regarding their current need for CIS and draft a solicitation with a reduced scope of work and a new base project estimate. The accompanying resolution has been amended to reflect the change.

Recommendation

This Request to Reject all Proposals for the Request to Advertise for Consultant Services for Construction Inspection Services has been prepared by the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) and is recommended for approval.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The requested services address the needs of various County departments requiring construction inspection services (CIS). The scope of work includes CIS for new building construction, building renovation, airfield, roadway, sidewalk, drainage, resurfacing and other related projects. The selected consultants' responsibilities will include overseeing, coordinating and inspecting the work of design consultants, surveyors and construction contractors, and may include contract monitoring and record keeping, approving and recommending requisitions for compensation, review of change orders, estimations, claims, scheduling and shop drawings review, and assuring compliance with all federal, state and local regulations, on behalf of Miami-Dade County. Rotation of assignments will be determined by the selected firms' initial ranking in the rotation, as determined by their three year work history. Subsequently, the rotations will be based on the amount of assignments held within this respective group. Work assignments will be issued on an as needed basis by County departments requesting these services.

Track Record / Monitor

EXPLANATION: On June 18, 2009, the original Request to Advertise (RTA) for this project was filed with the Clerk of the Board (COB). The Notice to Professional Consultants (NTPC) was e-solicited on June 22, 2009. Six addenda, issuing

clarifications and/or modifications to the original NTPC, were issued.

A revision to the original RTA was filed with the COB, on September 15, 2009. The revision to the RTA modified the Project Description, Minimum Qualifications Exceeding Legal Requirements, and Review Committee information. On October 23, 2009, the COB received 13 proposals in response to said solicitation. A First-Tier meeting was held, on December 15, 2009, at which the Competitive Selection Committee (CSC) motioned to eliminate two of the 13 respondents, based on their non-compliance with the Experience and Qualifications stipulations denoted in the NTPC. First-Tier Ranking was as follows:

As denoted above, First-Tier evaluation resulted in a tie for eighth place. Per Administrative Order 3-39, when there is a tie, the firm with the highest score on Criteria 1A shall advance. If a tie still exists, the firm with the highest score for Criteria 2A, then 3A, then 4A will be considered.

Tie-breaker #1 was applied utilizing the total points for Criteria 1A – Qualifications of Firms Including the Team Members Assigned to the Project. The application of tie-breaker # 1 resulted in a total of 151 for Corzo, Castella, Carballo, Thompson, Salman, P.A., and 150 points for Bermello, Ajamil and Partners. As a result, Corzo, Castella, Carballo, Thompson, Salman, P.A. was ranked in 8th place, and Bermello, Ajamil and Partners in 9th place.

At the conclusion of First-Tier the CSC motioned to waive Second-Tier evaluation and recommend the top two respondents, to the County Manager for negotiations of a PSA each, contingent on Small Business Development's (SBD) Community Business Enterprise (CBE) Compliance Review.

On January 13, 2009, SBD released its CBE Compliance Review deeming the first, second and fourth ranked firms as non-compliant with the CBE

Provisions. As a result, the First-Tier Ranking denoted above changed as follows:

The NTPC contained a preclusion provision that the Prime firms awarded OCI Project No. E09-OCI-01, C may not be awarded this PSA. As a result, A & P Consulting Transportation Engineers Corp. was precluded from being recommended for award. The County Manager approved negotiations with URS Corporation Southern, and Rodriguez and Quiroga Architects Chartered. The negotiation meeting was commenced and successfully concluded on July 22, 2010.

Since the conclusion of negotiations in July, OCI has conducted a survey of potential Miami-Dade County user departments. Said survey revealed that the need for this project has greatly decreased since its initial advertisement in 2009. Current research shows that the Department of General Services Administration (GSA) is capable of performing construction inspection services with in-house staff. In addition, Miami-Dade County's Equitable Distribution Program may also be utilized to fulfill said needs. As a result, OCI recommends that all proposals for the RTA for Consultant Services for Construction Inspection Services be rejected.



This revision to the Request to Advertise for Consultant Selection has been prepared by the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) and is respectfully submitted for your records.

On June 18, 2009, the attached Request to Advertise (RTA) was approved and filed with the Clerk of Courts. Subsequently, this project was advertised on June 22, 2009. Upon further review it was noted that the Project Description, Minimum Qualifications Exceeding Legal Requirements, and Review Committee information is not correctly denoted. As a result, please reflect subject modifications as follows:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The requested services shall address the needs of various County departments requiring construction inspection services. The scope of work includes construction inspection services for new building construction, building renovation, airfield, roadway, sidewalk, drainage, resurfacing and other related projects. The selected consultants' responsibilities will include overseeing, coordinating and inspecting the work of design consultants, surveyors and construction contractors, and may include contract monitoring and record keeping, approving and recommending requisitions for compensation, review of change orders, estimations, claims, scheduling and shop drawings review, and assuring compliance with all federal, state and local regulations, on behalf of Miami-Dade County. Rotation of assignments will be determined by the selected firms' initial ranking in the rotation, as determined by their three (3) year work history. Subsequently, the rotations will be based on the amount of assignments held within this respective group. Work assignments will be
