



RESOLUTION COMMEMORATING 25TH ANNIVERSARY
OF THE STEPHEN P. CLARK CENTER

WHEREAS, on April 17, 1986, the Stephen P. Clark Government Center building was officially dedicated, in conjunction with the opening for service of the first section of the Metromover, and it was to be, and still is, the headquarters of Miami-Dade County's government, with most County government offices located in or near the building; and

WHEREAS, because the state and federal courthouses are also located within 5 blocks of the building, the concept behind the Stephen P. Clark Government Center was to have federal, state, county and local governments all connected through the Metrorail system; and

WHEREAS, Stubbins Associates, Inc. was the architect of the Stephen P. Clark Government Center building and it was one of the first buildings to have the "open floor" concept of design; and

WHEREAS, the Stephen P. Clark Government Center building is a 510 foot tall skyscraper, with 31 stories and one of the highest height-to-floor ratios of any skyscraper, at 16.45 feet per floor; and

WHEREAS, the building was named for the former Mayor of Miami-Dade County and former Mayor of the City of Miami, Stephen P. Clark (1924-1996); and

WHEREAS, this year marks 25 years that the Stephen P. Clark Government Center building has been the headquarters of Miami-Dade County government and this Board desires to recognize its importance,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby commemorates the 25th Anniversary of the Stephen P. Clark Center.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Joe A. Martinez. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
