



RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 120TH AVENUE,
BETWEEN SW 224TH STREET AND BAILES ROAD, AS
“REVEREND WILLIAM WEATHERS AVENUE”

WHEREAS, in February 1980, Reverend William Weathers became pastor of the Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church in Goulds, Florida; and

WHEREAS, under Reverend Weather’s leadership, Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church’s sanctuary and fellowship hall was constructed in the mid 1980s and early 1990s, respectively, and the church was incorporated as a non-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Weathers lead Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church to great heights during his time its pastor and the church achieved numerous accomplishments, including, but not limited to: the purchase of 3.7 acres of land on the north side of the sanctuary; the purchase of a lot on S.W. 221st Street in Goulds, Florida; the construction of a three bedroom home on the aforementioned lot on 221st street; and the purchase of several vehicles for the sole purpose of providing transportation services for the members of Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS, during Reverend Weathers tenure, many vital programs were initiated, including the Outreach Ministry, the Pastor’s Aide Ministry, the Deacon Board Ministry, the Deaconess Board Ministry, the establishment of the Male Chorus, the Usher Board #3 Ministry, Male Ushers Ministry, Youth Choir, and a soup kitchen, which served at least 150 seniors, disabled and the needy residents in the Goulds area two days per week; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Weathers was elected treasurer for The Florida East Coast Ministries and Deacons Union, and served in this capacity for 27 years; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Weathers, in addition to his duties at Morning Star Baptist Church, worked with organizations such as the American Red Cross, Feed the Children, and Goulds Coalition of Ministers and Lay People; and

WHEREAS, under Reverend Weather's guidance, the Morning Star Baptist Church's membership has grown tremendously over the years; and

WHEREAS, the Morning Star Baptist Church family and the surrounding community are requesting that Reverend Weathers be honored by co-designating SW 120th Avenue, between 224th Street and Bailes Road, as "Reverend William Weathers Avenue;" and

WHEREAS, Reverend Weathers has made significant contributions to our community and his tireless work and efforts should never be forgotten; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to honor the memory of Reverend Weathers; and

WHEREAS, this proposed co-designation is a county road located in County Commission District 9,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having conducted a public hearing, co-designates SW 120th Avenue, between 224th Street and Bailes Road as "Reverend William Weathers Avenue."

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
