

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY CO-DESIGNATION OF THE PORTION OF SW 67 AVENUE THAT FALLS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FROM SW 144 STREET TO SW 152 STREET AS "JUDGE HENRY LEYTE-VIDAL WAY"

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2011, the Village of Palmetto Bay adopted Resolution No. 2011-21, a copy of which is attached and incorporated for reference, which co-designated the portion of SW 67 Avenue that falls within the boundaries of the Village of Palmetto Bay, essentially from SW 144 Street to SW 152 Street as "Judge Henry Leyte-Vidal Way," in recognition of Judge Henry Leyte-Vidal's contributions to the Palmetto Bay community; and

WHEREAS, Judge Leyte-Vidal was an outstanding member of the Palmetto Bay community who passed away recently; and

WHEREAS, in 1999, Judge Leyte-Vidal was appointed to the Miami-Dade County court and was subsequently appointed to serve as a member of the judiciary of the Circuit Court in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Judge Leyte-Vidal was a highly respected jurist and highly regarded for his professionalism, optimism, and dedication; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of this exceptional individual, the Mayor and Village Council requests that Miami-Dade County approve the aforementioned co-designation; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay would also like the County to install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the Village of Palmetto Bay co-designation of the portion of SW 67 Avenue that falls within the boundaries of the Village of Palmetto Bay, from SW 144 Street to SW 152 Street as “Judge Henry Leyte-Vidal Way.”

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Lynda Bell. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CO-DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF SW 67 AVENUE THAT FALLS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, ESSENTIALLY FROM SW 144 STREET TO SW 152 STREET AS "JUDGE HENRY LEYTE-VIDAL WAY"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. [Sponsored by Vice Mayor Pariser]

WHEREAS, Judge Henry Leyte-Vidal was an outstanding member of the Palmetto Bay community who passed recently; and

WHEREAS, Judge Leyte-Vidal earned his law degree from the University of Miami in 1977 and practiced law faithfully. In 1999, he was appointed to the Miami-Dade County court and then was appointed as a member of the judiciary of the Circuit Court in 2001. He was elected unopposed to this position in 2004; and

WHEREAS, Judge Leyte-Vidal was a highly respected jurist, well-respected by all due to his professionalism, optimism, and dedication; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of this outstanding individual, the Mayor and Village Council respectfully requests Miami-Dade County to co-designate the portion of SW 67 Avenue from SW 144 Street south to SW 152 Street as "Judge Henry Leyte-Vidal Way" in honor of his significant contributions to the Village and to Miami-Dade County; and


WHEREAS, SW 67 Avenue is a Miami-Dade County road and approval from the Miami-Dade Board of County Commission is necessary.
