RESOLUTION CO-DESIGNATING SW 102ND AVENUE
BETWEEN SW 120TH STREET AND SW 136TH STREET AS
“PAUL S. BARROW AVENUE”

WHEREAS, Paul S. Barrow was born October 13, 1964 in Sao Paulo Brazil and was educated in Miami-Dade County where he attended Arvida Middle School and Miami Sunset Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Barrow was a well liked mechanic who co-owned Devonaire Service & Tire, located at 12253 SW 112th Street in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Barrow was known to frequently waive charges for his service when customers were unable to pay; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Barrow was a community person who sponsored baseball teams and found joy in helping others; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Barrow was typically described “as a man of integrity” and someone to be emulated; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Barrow was known by his friends and associates “as a kind man, almost to a fault”; and

WHEREAS, in what seems to have been a random act of violence, Mr. Barrow was shot and killed inside his Kendall shop shortly after 8 a.m. on December 16, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Barrow is survived by his wife, Audree, his daughters Stefani Barrow, Jennifer Webb and Hannah Webb; a brother, Daniel Barrow, half-brother, Rick Barrow, and mother, Sylvia Barrow; and

WHEREAS, according to his wife, Mr. Barrow “was the kindest, most amazing husband of 20 years”; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Mr. Barrow; and

WHEREAS, this proposed co-designation is a county road located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having conducted a public hearing, co-designates SW 102nd Avenue, between SW 120th Street and SW 136th Street, as “Paul S. Barrow Avenue.”

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Lynda Bell. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
