RESOLUTION APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY CO-DESIGNATION OF THE PORTION OF SW 152 STREET THAT FALLS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FROM SW 80 AVENUE TO SW 79 AVENUE AS “DOLPHIN CROSSING”

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2010, the Village of Palmetto Bay adopted Resolution No. 2010-37, a copy of which is attached and incorporated for reference, which co-designated the portion of SW 152 Street that falls within the boundaries of the Village of Palmetto Bay, essentially from SW 80 Avenue to SW 79 Avenue as “Dolphin Crossing,” in recognition of the “A” rated Coral Reef Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, Coral Reef Elementary School is located within the Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the school continues to thrive under the outstanding direction, commitment, and dedication of its Principal Fred Albion, teachers and staff, and not to mention the hard work of its student body; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the high quality and standard of education of the institution and its responsiveness to the growing needs of the Village of Palmetto Bay and the larger Miami-Dade County community, the Village of Palmetto Bay requests that Miami-Dade County approve the aforementioned co-designation; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay would also like the County to install signage indicating this co-designation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this co-designation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the Village of Palmetto Bay co-designation of the portion of SW 152 Street that falls within the boundaries of the Village of Palmetto Bay, essentially from SW 80 Avenue to SW 79 Avenue, as “Dolphin Crossing.”

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.


