Subject: Option to Renew for One Year Countywide Contract for Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Sectional Lining Method, with County Option to Renew for an Additional Three Years on a Yearly Basis with Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. - Contract No. S-847; Project No. S-847 ESP

Recommendation

This first Option to Renew for Construction Contract No. S-847 between Miami-Dade County and Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Sectional Lining Method for an additional one (1) year period in the amount of \$650,000.00 has been prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and is recommended for approval.

Scope

This contract has countywide impact. It involves a general contracting firm providing services necessary to rehabilitate some of WASD's faulty sanitary sewers by the sectional lining method.

This project is part of WASD's on-going "Infiltration, Exfiltration and Inflow Program" established in 1993 by consent decree from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) as a measure to improve the sewer collection system. The project consists of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary for rehabilitating 8-inch through 36-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipe faults by the cured-in-place sectional lining method, under different work orders, at different locations, anywhere within the limits of Miami-Dade County, Florida, as ordered by WASD during a one-year period. This is a non-exclusive contract, and as such, the Department may issue other similar contracts for this type of work, and therefore does not guarantee that the full amount of the contract work as listed in the proposal will be issued to the contractor. The actual amount of work orders assigned will be the prerogative of WASD in its sole discretion and dependent only upon its needs.

The work will also include the following: reinstatement of service laterals, installation of pipe liners in easement areas, cleaning and video inspections, supplementary cleaning of the sewers to be repaired, and removal and proper disposal of solids as required, by-pass pumping of sewage, maintenance of traffic, and all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items and work for a completed project. The work shall be accomplished through sanitary sewer manhole openings, without disturbing any utility, street surface, or adjacent property.

This contract renewal is being awarded for an aggregate amount of up to \$650,000 for a 12-month period. The Contract will terminate upon the depletion of that amount, or the expiration of the 12-month period, whichever occurs first. If after the 12 month period, the Department is satisfied with the contractor's work, the Board of County Commissioners has the option to renew the contract for up to an additional two years, on a yearly basis, at the same unit prices used in the original contract.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This contract renewal has a one year financial commitment in the amount of \$650,000, which will be funded by Existing WASH Operating Revenue, and the Wastewater Renewal Fund. The project will have an impact on the Department's FY10-11 and FY11-12 budgets.

Track Record/Monitor

According to the Firm History Report as provided by the Department of Small Business Development, Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. has received seven (7) contracts valued at \$8,414,251 and two change orders valued at \$1,000,000 from Miami-Dade County in the last five years. The Office of Capital Improvements CIIS database contains 10 evaluations from County departments for Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. with an average rating of 3.6 which represents satisfactory performance. The day to day responsibilities for this project are the responsibility of Mr. Miguel Pichardo, Project Manager, Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department.


Background


WASH is required to make repairs to the sewage collection system to comply with the Volume Sewer Customer Ordinance and the Wellfield Protection Ordinance, Section 24-13.1 and Section 24-12.1 of the Miami-Dade County Code, respectively.

The initial contract award for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers by the Sectional Lining Method was approved administratively pursuant to Section 2-8.2.7 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, the Economic Stimulus Plan, to Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. This award was ratified by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) at its meeting held on September 21, 2010 via Resolution No. R-949-10. This contract gives the Board the authority to exercise three one year options to renew on a yearly basis. This is the first contract renewal.

THE CONDITION OF THIS BOND is that if Principal:

1. Performs all work due under the Contract, including but not limited to guarantees, warranties, and the curing of latent defects, said Contract being made a part of this bond by reference; and in the times and in the manner prescribed in the Contract, including any and all damages for delay; and
2. Promptly makes payments to all claimants, as defined in Section 255.05 (1), Florida Statutes, supplying Principal with labor, materials, or supplies, used directly or indirectly by Principal in the prosecution of the work provided for in the contract; and
3. Pays County for all losses, damages, including damages for delay, expenses, costs and attorney's fees, including appellate proceedings, that County sustains because of a default by Principal under the Contract, including but not limited to a failure to honor all guarantees and warranties or to cure latent defects in its work or materials within 5 years after completion of the work under the Contract; and
4. Performs the guarantee of all work and materials furnished under the contract for the time specified in the Contract, including all warranties and curing all latent defects within 5 years after completion of the work under the Contract;

then this bond is void, otherwise it remains in full force.

If no specific periods of warranty are stated in the Contract for any particular item or work, material or equipment, the warranty shall be deemed to be a period of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance by the County. This Bond does not limit the County's ability to pursue suits directly with the Principal seeking damages for latent defects in materials or workmanship, such actions being subject to the limitations found in Section 95.11(3)(c), Florida Statutes.

Any changes in or under the Contract Documents, and compliance or noncompliance with any formalities connected with the Contract or the changes, do not affect the Surety's obligation under this Bond.






