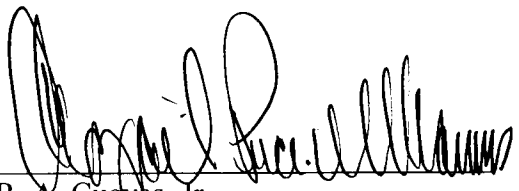

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH
CODESIGNATION OF WEST 60 STREET FROM WEST 12
AVENUE TO WEST 16 AVENUE AS "LIONS CLUB OF
HIALEAH STREET"

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2011, the Hialeah City Council adopted Resolution No. 11-30, which designated West 60 Street from West 12 Avenue to West 16 Avenue as "Lions Club of Hialeah Street," in recognition of outstanding service provided by the Lions Club organization to the City of Hialeah, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Lions Club is an organization that has more than 1.3 million members in 206 countries; and

WHEREAS, Lions Club programs include sight, hearing and speech conservation, diabetes awareness and youth outreach; and

WHEREAS, the Lions Club of Hialeah was chartered on May 23, 1997 and ever since has been providing community service and outreach programs to Hialeah residents of all ages; and

WHEREAS, West 60 Street from West 12 Avenue to West 16 Avenue is a city street located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 12,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Hialeah codesignation of West 60 Street from West 12 Avenue to West 16 Avenue as "Lions Club of Hialeah Street."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Miami-Dade County Public Works Department, the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Hialeah Police Department and the Hialeah Fire Department.

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF WEST 60 STREET, BETWEEN WEST 12 AVENUE AND WEST 16 AVENUE, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "LIONS CLUB OF HIALEAH STREET", IN HONOR AND RECOGNITION OF THE OUTSTANDING SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE LIONS CLUB ORGANIZATION TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND ITS RESIDENTS, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

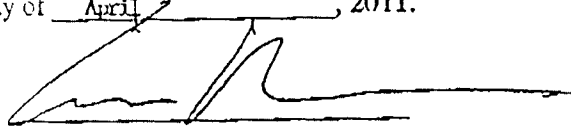

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of this resolution on March 23, 2011.

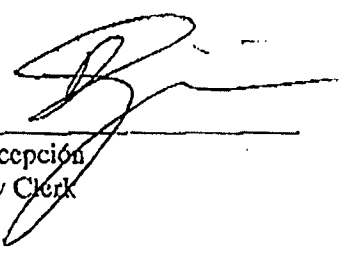
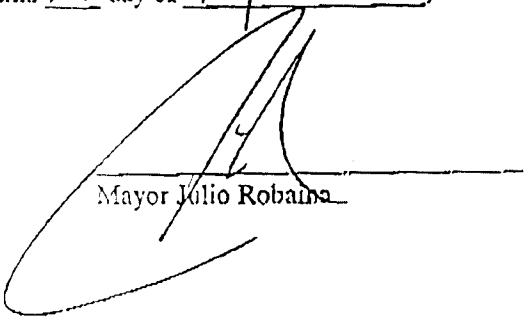

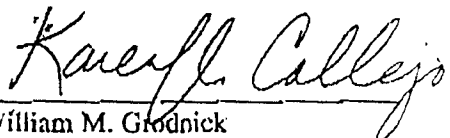
