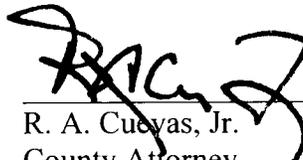

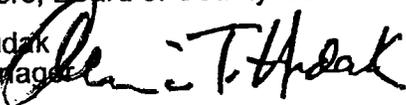

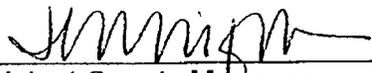

Subject: Resolution Approving Issuance of Revenue Refunding Bonds by the Miami-Dade County Health Facilities Authority on Behalf of Variety Children's Hospital d/b/a Miami Children's Hospital

Pursuant to the attached memorandum from the Miami-Dade County Health Facilities Authority (Authority), please find a resolution authorizing the issuance by the Authority of its Revenue Refunding Bonds (Bonds) in one or more series in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 on behalf of Variety Children's Hospital d/b/a Miami Children's Hospital (the "Hospital").

The principal and interest on the Bonds shall not constitute a debt, liability or a general obligation of the Authority, County, the State of Florida or any political subdivision of each, but shall be payable solely from the revenues of the Hospital.

The Series 2011 Bonds are expected to be issued in August 2011.

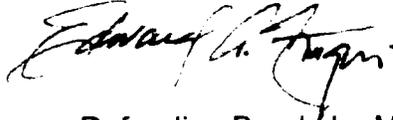

Subject: Resolution Approving Issuance of Revenue Refunding Bonds by Miami-Dade County Health Facilities Authority on Behalf of Variety Children's Hospital d/b/a Miami Children's Hospital

The Health Facilities Authority (the "Authority") requests that the attached Resolution be placed on the appropriate agenda for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") pursuant to Article XXIX of the Code of Metropolitan Miami-Dade County. The Resolution approves the issuance by the Authority of its revenue refunding bonds in the amount of \$30,000,000 ("Series 2011 Bonds") on behalf of Variety Children's Hospital d/b/a Miami Children's Hospital ("Hospital").

Scope

Miami Children's Hospital serves all of Miami-Dade County.

Funding Impact/Funding Source

The issuance of the Series 2011 Bonds will have no financial or fiscal impact on the County since the Series 2011 Bonds shall not constitute a debt, liability or a general obligation of the Authority or the County and the interest and principal on the Series 2011 Bonds shall be paid solely from the revenues of the Hospital.

Track Record/Monitoring

The repayment of the Bonds will be monitored by the Hospital.

Background

Ordinance No.79-92, as amended, empowered the Authority to issue tax exempt revenue bonds on behalf of hospitals and other health providers for the purpose of providing additional means to assist in the development and maintenance of the County's health facilities.

In 2006, the Authority issued its Hospital Revenue Bonds (Miami Children's Hospital Project), Series 2006A-1 on behalf of the Hospital (the "2006 Bonds"). The Hospital has requested that the Authority issue the Series 2011 Bonds in an aggregated principal not to exceed \$30,000,000 (i) to refund all of the 2006 Bonds; (ii) to fund any reserves; and (iii) to pay certain costs incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The request is being made pursuant to the Code which requires Board approval prior to the issuance of the Series 2011 Bonds by the Authority.

The Series 2011 Bonds are expected to be issued in August 2011.

RESOLUTION APPROVING ISSUANCE BY MIAMI-DADE COUNTY HEALTH FACILITIES AUTHORITY OF ITS REVENUE REFUNDING BONDS IN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000,000 TO REFUND CERTAIN OUTSTANDING BONDS ON BEHALF OF MIAMI CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

WHEREAS, this Board enacted Ordinance No. 79-92 on October 16, 1979 as codified in the Code of Metropolitan Miami-Dade County in Article XXIX (the "Ordinance") creating the Miami-Dade County Health Facilities Authority (the "Authority") and empowering it to issue tax-exempt revenue bonds upon its approval for the purpose of providing additional means to assist in the development and maintenance of the County's health facilities pursuant to Chapter 154, Part III, Florida Statutes (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, Variety Children's Hospital d/b/a Miami Children's Hospital, a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Hospital"), has requested the Authority to issue its Hospital Revenue Refunding Bonds (Miami Children's Hospital Project) (the "Bonds") in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 aggregate principal amount (i) to refund all of the Authority's outstanding Hospital Revenue Bonds (Miami Children's Hospital Project), Series 2006A-1; (ii) to fund any reserves; and (iii) to pay certain bond issuance costs; and

WHEREAS, the Authority intends to issue the Bonds, subject to the prior approval of their issuance by this Board and final approval of the financing documents by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, finding that the issuance of the Bonds will inure to the benefit of the health care for the citizens of Miami-Dade County, this Board desires to approve the issuance of the Bonds for the purpose of complying with the Ordinance and the Act,

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The issuance of the Bonds by the Authority on behalf of the Hospital in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 is approved for purposes of the Ordinance and the Act.

Section 2. The Bonds and the interest on the Bonds shall not constitute a debt, liability or general obligation of the Authority, the County or of the State of Florida or of any political subdivision of each but shall be payable solely from the revenues or other moneys specifically provided by the Hospital for the payment of the Bonds and neither the faith and credit nor any taxing power of the Authority, the County or of the State of Florida or of any political subdivision of each is pledged to the payment of the principal or interest on the Bonds.
