RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING JOSE R. INFANTE

LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
BOARD

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) previously established the Naranja Lakes Community Redevelopment Agency (“CRA”) through Ordinance 02-216 and appointed an initial CRA Board of Commissioners (“CRA Board”) pursuant to Section 163.356, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board, as the governing body of the CRA, has the authority to make appointments to the CRA Board, when necessary, after the establishment of the initial CRA Board; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 06-64 amended Ordinance 02-216 to allow future appointments and reappointments to the CRA Board to be accomplished by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the term of Jose R. Infante has expired and the Board wishes to reappoint him; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to fill a vacancy caused by the resignation of a CRA board member; and

WHEREAS, Charles D. Lopez and Beatriz Meiggs-Consuegra have been nominated to serve as a CRA board members,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

Section 1. Jose R. Infante is hereby reappointed to a four-year term commencing on October 22, 2010 and expiring on October 22, 2014.

Section 2. Charles D. Lopez is hereby appointed to a four-year term, commencing on the effective date of this resolution.

Section 3. Beatriz Meiggs-Consuegra is hereby appointed to a four-year term, commencing on the effective date of this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Lynda Bell. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption.
