RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR
OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO REVIEW ALL
COUNTY LAWS, RULES AND PROCESSES FOR
PROCURING GOODS, SERVICES, AND LEASES AND
PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR OBTAINING
MORE FAVORABLE PRICING FOR THE COUNTY
AND/OR LOWER PROCUREMENT COSTS

WHEREAS, the County expends significant resources on procuring goods,
services and leases for the County; and

WHEREAS, the County's procurement processes are governed by state law,
County Ordinances, Implementing Orders, and internal departmental policies; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to evaluate the County's current laws, rules and
processes for procuring goods, services (including all professional services), and leases to
determine if changes to those laws, rules and processes will result in more favorable
pricing to the County and/or lower procurement costs,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the County
Mayor or the Mayor's designee is hereby directed to review all County laws, rules and
process for procuring goods, services (including professional services), and leases to
determine whether changes to those laws, rules and processes would result in more
favorable pricing to the County and/or lower procurement costs. The County Mayor or
the Mayor's designee is further directed to provide a written report to the Board, not later

than 90 days following the date of this resolution, detailing all recommended changes to those laws, rules and processes and the expected savings from such changes.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and the Co-Sponsor is Vice Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
