RESOLUTION NO. 10-859

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING BOTTLE BRUSH DRIVE AS BOTTLEBRUSH DRIVE; AUTHORIZING TOWN OFFICIALS TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO DESIGNATE THE ROAD; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO NOTIFY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CLERK AND THE UNITED STATES POST OFFICE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the original name that was given to the street known in Miami-Dade County records as Bottle Brush Drive is in fact Bottlebrush Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County records were erroneously recorded recognizing the street in the form of two words instead of one word; and

WHEREAS, a Miami Lakes resident of over 30 years of the aforementioned street has contacted the Town regarding this error; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Miami Lakes has taken the initial steps in remediating this issue by replacing the Town's street sign with a sign that reflects the street name as one word instead of two words.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Designation of Roadway. Bottle Brush Drive is hereby recognized by the Town as Bottlebrush Drive.

Section 3. Authorization of Town Officials. The Town Manager and/or his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Direction to Clerk. The Town Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners, Miami-Dade County Clerk and the United States Postal Service in order to verify the street designation for postal records.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


