

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING UP TO \$1,519 CASH ALLOCATION TO THE TEATRO EN MIAMI CORP., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, TO BE FUNDED FROM THE UNSPENT BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 5 FY 2008-09 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

**WHEREAS**, Teatro en Miami, Corp., has requested a cash allocation for the “TEMFest 2011”; and

**WHEREAS**, “TEMFest 2011” is an event which features 72 local artists offering the most representative works of the theater scene; and

**WHEREAS**, an estimated 12,200 children, adults, tourists and family members will make up the audiences for 31 performances featured during “TEMFest 2011”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Teatro en Miami, Corp., is a not-for-profit organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the “TEMFest 2011” will be held during the month of October 2011, and \$1,519 of the cash allocation shall be funded from the unspent balance of the District 5 FY 2008-09 In-kind Reserve Fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board authorizes a \$1,519 cash allocation to the Teatro en Miami Corp., for the October 2011 TEMFest 2011 to be funded from the unspent balance of the District 5 FY 2008-09 In-kind Reserve Fund.





#### Purpose of Form

## **Recommendation**

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends this item move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for funding of this request.

## **Background**

A cash allocation for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization, Teatro en Miami, Corp., for their "TEMFest 2011" event held during the month of October, 2011.

In-kind services have been requested through a cash allocation up to an amount not to exceed \$1,519 for the event to be held during the month of October 2011. This event will be funded from the unspent balance of the District 5 FY 2008-09 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2010-11, Teatro en Miami, Corp., received no funding for this event.
