Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$476,695.23 to AGC Electric, Inc. for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Electronic Speed Feedback Signs and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Electronic Speed Feedback Signs* (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20110103) in the amount of \$476,695.23 to AGC Electric, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWMD) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

Proceeds from a Charter County Transportation System Sales Surtax Bond Sale will be used to fund this project; therefore, review by the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required before final approval by the BCC.

Scope

The work to be performed under the life of this Contract includes the installation of electronic speed feedback signs at various locations within Miami-Dade County (County).

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The value of this contract award is \$476,695.23 and will be funded from Charter County Transportation Surtax 2010 Bond Proceeds as programmed within PWWMD's Multi-Year Capital Budget. The base contract amount is \$407,763.60, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There are no recurring operation or maintenance costs anticipated with this Contract.

The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. The funding index code for this project is CPEPTP600SCH.

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

Track Record/Monitor

AGC Electric, Inc. is currently performing work for PWWMD at a satisfactory level. PWWMD has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database and found 16 awarded construction contracts as follows:

- one for the Internal Services Department (ISD), and
- 15 for PWWMD.

The referenced database also lists a total of seven contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of 3.7 (satisfactory performance) out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating.

The Sustainability, Planning and Economic Enhancement Department (SPEED) History of Violations report lists no violations for this Contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, AGC Electric, Inc., Company Principals are Tomas V. Curbelo, Enrique I. Guzman and Pierrette De La Sierra and the Company's address is listed as 2600 West 79 Street, Hialeah, Florida 33016.

Following PWWMD's standard operating procedures, after award of this Contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The responsible staff person for all PTP projects in PWWMD is Mr. Frank Aira, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, Project Coordinator, for day-to-day responsibilities.

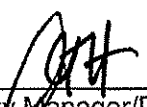
Background

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWMD continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contract (MCC) process available under the MCC 7360 Program. Through this process, PWWMD forwards a Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) by way of facsimile transmission to a pool of firms that have registered with ISD for the respective trade. Additionally, PWWMD advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWWMD staff submitted the referenced project to the SPEED Review Committee. The Review Committee met on July 19, 2011, reviewed RPQ No. 20110103, and recommended no measures. A Community Workforce Program Goal of 13.90 percent has been established for this project as several work locations fall within a Designated Target Area. On August 11, 2011, PWWMD forwarded an RPQ for the PTP Electronic Speed Feedback Signs Project, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08, to a list of 42 pre-registered firms. A total of 13 firms purchased contract documents and five firms proffered a bid.

On September 14, 2011, AGC Electric, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive, responsible base bid of \$407,763.60, nineteen percent below the County's cost estimate; the second lowest bidder, Under Power Corp. proffered a base bid of \$449,621.70, ten percent over the lowest bidder; and the third lowest bidder, Solares Electrical Services, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$500,874.84, eleven percent over the second lowest bidder. Based on the results of the solicitation, PWWMD issued a recommendation for award on September 27, 2011 for RPQ No. 20110103 to AGC Electric, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC in accordance with PTP guidelines.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment and tools to perform all operations necessary for the furnishing and installing of new solar powered electronic speed feedback signs, pedestrian poles, foundations, pullboxes, conduit, and service wire as shown in the contract plans and specifications at designated locations.

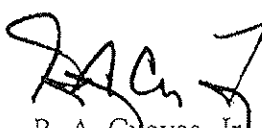

This letter will serve as your notification that you have been recommended for award for the above referenced RPQ based on your Price Quotation submitted on Wednesday, September 14, 2011. The total RPQ amount is for four hundred seventy-six thousand six hundred ninety-five dollars and twenty-three cents (\$476,695.23). This includes a base contract amount of four hundred seven thousand seven hundred sixty-three dollars and sixty cents (\$407,763.60), a contingency amount of forty thousand seven hundred seventy-six dollars and thirty-six cents (\$40,776.36), and dedicated allowances totaling twenty-eight thousand one hundred fifty-five dollars and twenty-seven cents (\$28,155.27). The contract duration is established as **198-calendar days**. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required in Contract No. MCC 7360 Plan, Section 2.0 Special Conditions, Page 16, Article 2.11, **PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**. (The **original attached documents** must be used and three (3) sets must be provided).
2. Letter from Bonding Agent granting Miami-Dade County authorization to date the Performance Bond.
3. Copies of current insurance certificates.
4. Copies of required license(s).
5. Submit Workforce Plan to the issuing/user department within fifteen (15) days of Notice of Award for project specific and within fifteen (15) days from Notice to proceed for work orders.

The preceding documents are required as outlined within Contract MCC 7360 Plan and to be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the document(s) within the specified time, or any extension granted, will result in the award being rescinded. Subsequent to the review and approval of the aforementioned documents, you are required to obtain the required permits in the time stipulated in the RPQ. Upon obtaining the permit(s), a copy(s) must be submitted to the Project Manager prior to commencement of work.

No work is to be performed without a permit unless the Project Manager issues a written directive to proceed without permit(s). This letter will also serve as a reminder that all work must be performed according to the scope of work and contract's terms and conditions, all permits and inspections and in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, codes and regulations.

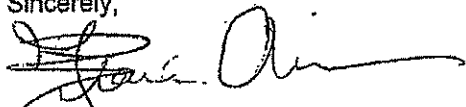
Additionally, this contract, along with any future contracts awarded to your firm, have very similar completion schedules and competing deadlines. Please be advised that your firm must have the resources to ensure work proceeds without delay once the "Notice to Proceed" is issued. This will result in your firm working on multiple contracts concurrently. Lack of equipment and/or personnel will not be reason for delay.

Further, it shall be understood that since proceeds from the Charter County Transportation System Sales Surtax levied pursuant to Section 29.121 of the Code of Miami-Dade County may be used to pay for all or some part of the cost of this contract, no award of this contract shall be effective and thereby give rise to a contractual relationship with the County unless and until the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) and the County Commission have approved the award of the contract, and such award becomes final (either by expiration of 10 days after such award without veto by the Mayor, or by Commission override of a veto).
