RESOLUTION WAIVING THE TERM LIMITS OF  
SECTION 2-250 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY FOR ALEJANDRO AGUIRRE AND  
REAPPOINTING HIM TO THE CULTURAL AFFAIRS  
COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, Alejandro Aguirre is currently serving on the Cultural Affairs Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-250 of the Code of Miami-Dade County imposes term limits on members of County Boards; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the Board of County Commissioners may by resolution adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present waive a term limit applicable to a member of a County Board; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limit for Alejandro Aguirre and reappoint him to the Cultural Affairs Council for another term,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that, pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, the term limit applicable to Alejandro Aguirre is hereby waived by a two-thirds (2/3) vote and he is hereby reappointed to another term on the Cultural Affairs Council.
