RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION OF FEES COLLECTED FOR ISSUING PARKING PERMITS FOR PERSONS TRANSPORTING YOUNG CHILDREN AND STROLLERS TO THE CHILDREN'S HOME SOCIETY OF FLORIDA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 94-104 provides that one-third of fees collected for issuing parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers shall be distributed to private not-for-profit, non-denominational agencies providing services for severely abused or neglected children; and

**WHEREAS**, the Children's Home Society of Florida is a private 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, non-denominational entity whose mission is to, among other things, provide needed services to severely abused or neglected children; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County to provide funding to this entity,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee is hereby directed to distribute funds collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers as follows:

Children's Home Society of Florida

\$50,000.00
