RESOLUTION APPROVING ALLOCATION OF \$1 MILLION TO SBC SENIOR HOUSING LLC FROM BUILDING BETTER COMMUNITIES GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROGRAM PROJECT NUMBER 249 – “PRESERVATION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING UNITS AND EXPANSION OF HOME OWNERSHIP” TO FUND DEVELOPMENT OF A SENIOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT IN DISTRICT 9

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-918-04 (the “Affordable Housing Resolution”), the voters approved the issuance of general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$194,997,000 to construct and improve affordable housing for the elderly and families; and

WHEREAS, Appendix A to the Affordable Housing Resolution lists projects eligible for funding from the Building Better Communities General Obligation Bond Program (the “BBC Program”) by project number, municipal project location, BCC district, project name, project description, street address and allocation; and

WHEREAS, one of the projects listed in Appendix A to the Affordable Housing Resolution and approved by the voters for funding is Project No. 249 – “Preservation of Affordable Housing Units and Expansion of Home Ownership” with an original allocation of \$137.7 million (“Project No. 249”); and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the development of low income elderly affordable housing in District 9; and

WHEREAS, this need may be satisfied in part through the proposed development of approximately 79 units of affordable housing for elderly persons to be sited at 11111 Pinkston Drive, Miami, Florida 33176 (the “Senior Housing Project”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-55-11, as amended, this Board previously allocated \$1 million to SBC Senior Housing, LLC, the developer of the Senior Housing Project, to fund a portion of the development of the Senior Housing Project; and

WHEREAS, the developer has received funding commitments equal to \$10 million as follows: \$7 million of Florida housing tax credits, \$2 million of surtax dollars, and the \$1 million BBC GOB Program funding already allocated by the Board to the Senior Housing Project; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the provision of affordable housing throughout the County is a priority of this Board; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to approve an additional \$1 million allocation from Project No. 249 to SBC Senior Housing, LLC to fund the a portion of the development of the Senior Housing Project in District 9, subject to Board approval of all necessary agreements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. This Board hereby approves the allocation of \$1,000,000 to SBC Senior Housing, LLC from the \$137.7 million allocated for BBC Program Project No. 249 – “Preservation of Affordable Housing Units and Expansion of Home Ownership” to fund a portion of the development of the Senior Housing Project in District 9, subject to Board approval of all necessary agreements.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

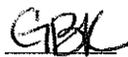
