Subject: Resolution Ratifying Acceptance and Execution of a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Florida Department of Transportation for Additional Fiscal Year 2010 State Funding for the Route 288 (Kendall Cruiser) Enhanced Bus Service in the Amount of \$552,200; Authorizing a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement to Provide Additional Fiscal Year 2012 State Funding in the Amount of \$800,000; And Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax as a Local Match

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopt the attached resolution ratifying the acceptance and execution of a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) between Miami-Dade County and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for additional Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 State funding for the Route 288 (Kendall Cruiser) Enhanced Bus Service (EBS) in the amount of \$552,200 and the execution of a SJPA in substantially the form attached hereto, with FDOT to provide additional FY 2012 State funding in the amount of \$800,000 for this service.

It is further recommended that the Board ratify the local match of \$552,200 for FY 2010 and approve the local match of \$800,000 for FY 2012 to come from Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) Operating funds, which includes a portion of Charter County Transportation Surtax Bond proceeds.

This contract award recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This contract award recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

SCOPE

While this route runs through County Commission Districts 7, 10 and 11, the impact of the project benefits the riding public, and is therefore, countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

The State is providing an additional \$800,000 in FY 2012 funding for the Kendall Cruiser EBS through this SJPA. MDT Operating funds will provide the \$800,000 local match for a total SJPA amount of \$1,600,000. The State's total funding participation to date for this service is \$1,807,200.

The current and future on-going annual operating cost for the Kendall Cruiser Bus Service is \$1,313,000 and is budgeted within the 29.2 million revenue miles.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

MDT has entered into numerous funding agreements with FDOT over the course of more than twenty-five (25) years. The Project Manager for this SJPA is Robert Villar, Chief, Budget and Performance Reporting.

DELEGATED AUTHORITY

In accordance with Section 2-8.3 of the Miami-Dade County Code related to identifying delegation of Board authority, there are no authorities beyond that specified in the resolution which include authority for the Mayor, Mayor's designee or the MDT Director to execute the agreement and receive and expend these and any additional funds should they become available.

BACKGROUND

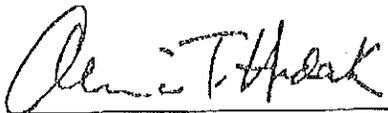
The State of Florida's Service Development Program provides funding for the improvement or expansion of public transit services with a focus on innovative technologies, marketing community outreach, and other techniques used for increasing service to the riding public. Projects funded with Service Development monies are limited to three (3) years or less in duration. If successful, the program must be continued using local revenues when the Service Development period is concluded.

On June 3, 2008, Resolution R-641-08 was approved by the Board for a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) providing State funding in the amount of \$1,255,000 for the operation of the Kendall Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service on Kendall Drive. The State funding from this JPA and the \$1,255,000 local match provided a total of \$2,510,000 for this service.

On February 17, 2010, a subsequent Supplemental JPA providing MDT \$552,200 in additional FY 2010 funding for the Kendall Cruiser EBS (formally known as the Kendall BRT) was executed by the State and is included as an attachment to this document. The \$552,200 equal match provided a total of \$1,104,400 for this SJPA. A Resolution ratifying the acceptance, execution and the use of MDT operating funds as the local match for this SJPA is being requested through this subsequent Board action.

The Board approved Resolution R-444-11 on June 7, 2011, which included an amendment of the original name and description of the Kendall BRT bus route service to the Kendall Cruiser EBS and changed the western terminus from SW 167th Avenue to the West Kendall Transit Terminal (SW 162nd Avenue) operating along Kendall Drive. The Kendall Cruiser EBS extends eleven miles from Dadeland North Metrorail Station to SW 162nd Avenue along SW 88th Street (Kendall Drive/SR 94) and State Rd 878. The alignment has twelve (12) bus stops in each direction along with the route termini and features sixty-foot hybrid diesel-electric buses equipped with Transit Signal Priority (TSP) to enable the buses to save time at intersections while operating in mixed traffic. The service operates at twelve (12) minute peak headways. The current average weekday boardings is 974.

Finally, the State is providing \$800,000 in FY 2012 funding through this SJPA, which represents the final year of funding allowed for this service under the State of Florida's Service Development program. The State's total funding participation for this service, inclusive of this SJPA is \$2,607,200.

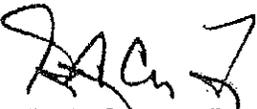

RESOLUTION RATIFYING ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A SUPPLEMENTAL JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ADDITIONAL FISCAL YEAR 2010 STATE FUNDING FOR THE ROUTE 288 (KENDALL CRUISER) ENHANCED BUS SERVICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$552,200; AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL JOINT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT FOR ADDITIONAL FISCAL YEAR 2012 STATE FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$800,000; AND AUTHORIZING USE OF CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM SURTAX FUNDS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida is authorized to enter into agreements to provide State funding for transportation programs and projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That this Board ratifies the agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Florida Department of Transportation, in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, for \$552,200 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 State funding for the Kendall Cruiser Enhanced Bus Service; and further authorizes an agreement providing \$800,000 in additional FY 2012 State funding for this service.

Section 2. That this Board further authorizes the Mayor, Mayor's designee, or Miami-Dade Transit Director, to execute such contracts and agreements as are approved by the County Attorney's Office; to receive and expend funds in accordance with such aforementioned contracts and agreements; to receive and expend any additional funds should they become

available; and to file and execute any additional agreements, revisions, or amendments as required to carry out the projects for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Section 3. That the County staff is authorized to furnish such additional information as the FDOT may require in connection with the application for the improvement.

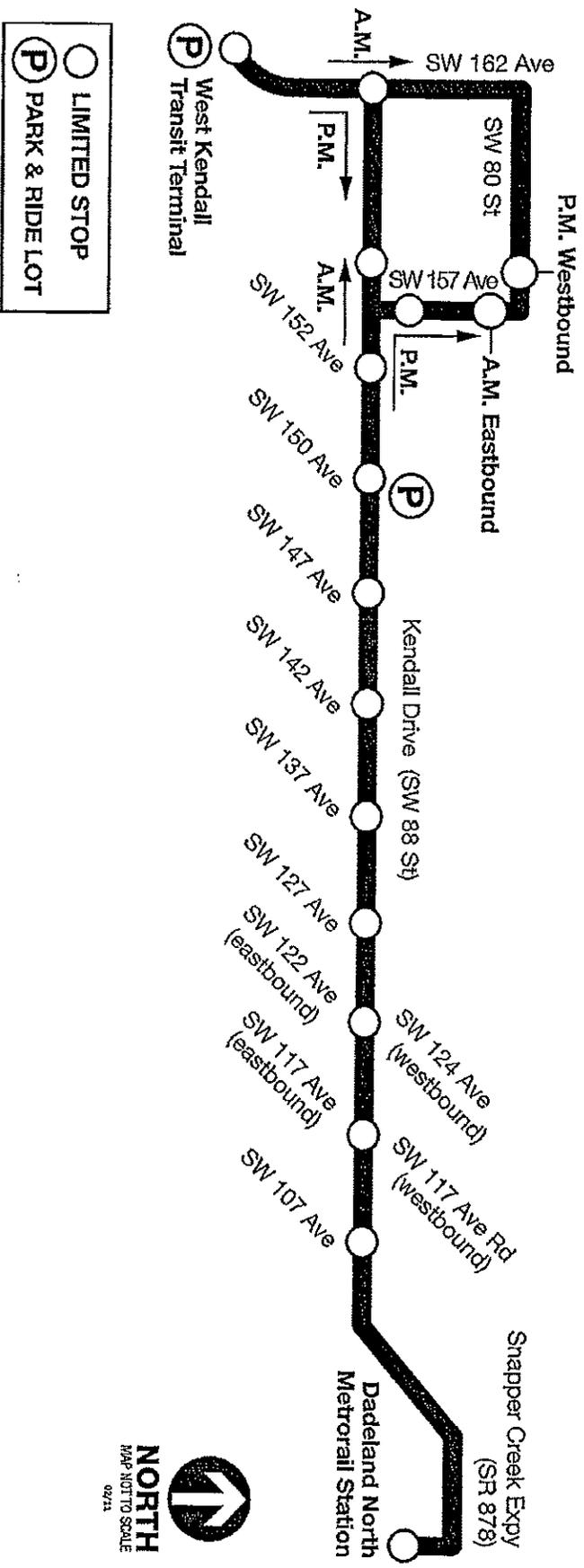
