



RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH  
CODESIGNATION OF WEST 16 AVENUE FROM WEST  
80 STREET TO WEST 82 STREET AS "ALEXIS FARI YEYILLE  
WAY"

**WHEREAS**, on March 27th, 2012, the Hialeah City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-35 which codesignated West 16 Avenue from West 80 Street to West 82 Street as "Alexis Fari Yeyille Way;" in recognition of his contributions to the City of Hialeah, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, Alexis Fari Yeyille was born in Cuba and began his career in radio there; and

**WHEREAS**, Yeyille left his native country and found exile in the United States, where he made Hialeah his home; and

**WHEREAS**, Yeyille began working with radio station WMIE, currently WQBA, where he served as mentor to dozens of Cuban exile radio personalities; and

**WHEREAS**, while hosting "El Show de las Factorias and El Reinado de las Factorias", Yeyille set the record for the highest ratings in a morning show within his time slot, a record he holds to this day; and

**WHEREAS**, Alexis Fari Yeyille still calls Hialeah his home; and

**WHEREAS**, West 16 Avenue from West 80 Street to SW 82 Street is a city street located in the City of Hialeah; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 13,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the City of Hialeah codesignation of West 16 Avenue from West 80 Street to West 82 Street as “Alexis Fari Yeyille Way”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department and Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Hialeah Police Department and the Hialeah Fire Department:

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE CODESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF WEST 16 AVENUE, BETWEEN WEST 80 STREET AND WEST 82 STREET, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, PRESENTLY UNNAMED, AS "ALEXIS FARI YEYILLE WAY", IN HONOR AND RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF ALEXIS FARI YEYILLE AS A RADIO COMMENTATOR TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND THE CUBAN EXILE COMMUNITY, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

**WHEREAS**, the codesignation of that portion of West 16 Avenue, between West 80 Street and West 82 Street, Hialeah, Florida, presently unnamed, as "ALEXIS FARI YEYILLE WAY", is in honor and recognition of the contributions of Alexis Fari Yeyille to the City of Hialeah and the Cuban exile community; and

**WHEREAS**, Alexis Fari Yeyille, born in Sancti Spiritus, Cuba, began his career as a public servant as an employee of the Mayor of the City of Havana, and later served as the Minister of Commerce of the Republic of Cuba; and

**WHEREAS**, he later established the *Colegio Nacional de Locutores*, or National College of Radio Announcers, and was a professor of elocution, influencing the lives of countless students; and

**WHEREAS**, Alexis Fari Yeyille left his native country and found exile in the United States, where he made Hialeah his home; and

**WHEREAS**, in Hialeah, Alexis Fari Yeyille began working with radio station WMIE, currently WQBA, where he served as a mentor for dozens of Cuban exile radio personalities; and

**WHEREAS**, while hosting *El Show de las Factorias* and *El Reinado de las Factorias*, Alexis Fari Yeyille set the record for the highest ratings in a morning show within his time slot – a record he holds to this day; and

**WHEREAS**, Alexis Fari Yeyille, or "*El Morito Bien Administrado*," as he is known to his friends, still calls Hialeah his home; and






