

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 11 STREET FROM SW 137 AVENUE TO SW 137 PLACE AS "HIGINIO JESUS DURAN STREET"

**WHEREAS**, Higinio Jesus Duran was born in Cuba in 1929 and came to the United States to start a new life in 1969; and

**WHEREAS**, Duran was always involved in helping the community, whether it was by painting over graffiti, cleaning the streets or volunteering as a baseball coach; and

**WHEREAS**, Duran volunteered his time and served as a baseball coach at Tamiami Park from 1989 until 1995, when he passed away due to a drowning accident; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 11 Street from SW 137 Avenue to SW 137 Place is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Higinio Jesus Duran with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 11 Street from SW 137 Avenue to SW 137 Place as "Higinio Jesus Duran Street".

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Land Development/Right-of-Way

Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
