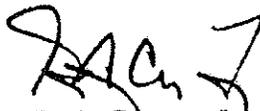

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI  
CODESIGNATION OF NW 28TH STREET FROM NW 7TH  
AVENUE TO NW 12TH AVENUE AS "BETH LANG WAY"

**WHEREAS**, on December 15, 2011, the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution No. R-11-0535 which codesignated NW 28th Street from NW 7th Avenue to NW 12th Avenue as "Beth Lang Way," in recognition of her contributions to the City of Miami, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, Beth Lang was born in Red Bank, New Jersey in 1938, and achieved a degree in nursing and a master's degree in social work; and

**WHEREAS**, Lang, who herself overcame alcohol and prescription drug addiction, dedicated her life's work to substance abuse treatment programs; and

**WHEREAS**, shortly after Lang moved to Miami in 1987, she became the director of Better Way, a substance abuse treatment center; and

**WHEREAS**, along with the Homeless Trust, Beth Lang helped raise community consciousness and made it possible to shrink the homeless population in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Beth Lang passed away on September 19, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, NW 28th Street from NW 7th Avenue to NW 12th Avenue is a city street located in the City of Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Miami wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 3,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the City of Miami codesignation of NW 28th Street from NW 7th Avenue to NW 12th Avenue as “Beth Lang Way.”

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami Police Department, and the Miami Fire-Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION, WITH ATTACHMENT(S), CODESIGNATING NORTHWEST 28TH STREET FROM NORTHWEST 7TH AVENUE TO NORTHWEST 12TH AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS "BETH LANG WAY;" FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INSTRUCT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Northwest 28th Street from Northwest 7th Avenue to Northwest 12th Avenue, Miami, Florida, is codesignated as "Beth Lang Way".

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to instruct the Director of Public Works to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, Solid Waste, Miami-Dade County Public Works, and the United States Postal Service.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}

Footnotes:

{1} If the Mayor does not sign this Resolution, it shall become effective at the end of ten calendar days from the date it was passed and adopted. If the Mayor vetoes this Resolution, it shall become effective immediately upon override of the veto by the City Commission.
