RESOLUTION APPOINTING RONALD E. FRAZIER, AIA TO
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE NW 79TH
STREET COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") adopted Ordinance No. 11-55 appointing the initial board of commissioners of the N.W. 79th Street Corridor Community Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") pursuant to Section 163.356, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, this Board on July 19, 2011 adopted Ordinance No. 11-55, establishing and appointing the members of the board of commissioners of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.356(2), Florida Statutes and Section 3(a) of Ordinance No. 11-55, the Agency's board "shall consist of not fewer than five or more than nine commissioners" of which pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Miami-Dade County ("County") and the Agency one seat is reserved for a County commissioner; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8(c) of Ordinance No, 11-55, "All future appointments of chairs, vice-chairs and members of the Agency shall be made by resolution of the Board"; and

WHEREAS, the Agency currently consists of seven (7) commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint Ronald E. Frazier, AIA, whose resume is attached hereto as Exhibit A, to serve as a commissioner of the Agency,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. The Board hereby appoints Ronald E. Frazier, AIA to serve as an Agency commissioner for a term of four (4) years.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption.


