

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE ROAD
CODESIGNATION OF MILLER ROAD/S.W. 56 STREET
BETWEEN S.W. 120 AVENUE AND S.W. 117 AVENUE AS
"PASTOR MARVIN GOCHENOUR WAY"

WHEREAS, during the 2012 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed HB 7039, which, among other codesignations, codesignated Miller Road/S.W. 56 Street between S.W. 120 Avenue and S.W. 117 Avenue as "Pastor Marvin Gochenour Way"; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 1957, Marvin Gochenour became pastor of First Baptist Church of Westwood Lake, a small mission work that met at the Royal Palm Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, six months thereafter, the church was able to organize as an independent Baptist church; and

WHEREAS, in addition to founding the First Baptist Church of Westwood Lake, Pastor Gochenour also founded the Westwood Christian School and Circle C. Youth Ranch; and

WHEREAS, after more than 46 years of faithful service, Pastor Gochenour retired in 2004 as Pastor of First Baptist Church of Westwood Lake; and

WHEREAS, during the 2012 session, the Florida Legislature honored Pastor Gochenour's service to the community over the past 50 years by codesignating Miller Road/S.W. 56 Street between S.W. 120 Avenue and S.W. 117 Avenue; and

WHEREAS, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of road codesignation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road codesignation; and

WHEREAS, Miller Road/S.W. 56 Street between S.W. 120 Avenue and S.W. 117 Avenue is a county road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the state codesignation of Miller Road/S.W. 56 Street between S.W. 120 Avenue and S.W. 117 Avenue as “Pastor Marvin Gochenour Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Land Development/Right-of-Way Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
