

Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$580,494.91 to AGC Electric, Inc. for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Traffic Signal Intersections and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Traffic Signal Intersections* (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Request for Price Quotation No. 20120028) in the amount of \$580,494.91 to AGC Electric, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

This contract award recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This contract award recommendation may only be considered by the BCC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract includes the installation of traffic signals at various locations within Miami-Dade County.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$580,494.91 and will be funded from the Surtax. The base contract amount is \$472,102.60, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. The estimated operation and maintenance costs are \$2,800 annually for each Signal installed, and will be funded through PWWM's general fund.

The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project will be allocated from the respective Commission District's yearly PTP allocation and may be supplemented by other funding sources when available. The funding index code for this project is CPEPTP600SGL.

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

Track Record/Monitor

AGC Electric, Inc. is currently performing work for PWWM at a satisfactory level. PWWM has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System database and found 18 awarded construction contracts as follows:

- one from the Internal Services Department, and
- 17 from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of nine contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of 3.7 (satisfactory performance) out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. The Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this Contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, AGC Electric, Inc., Company Principals are Tomas V. Curbelo, Enrique I. Guzman and Pierrette De La Sierra, and the Company's address is listed as 2600 West 79 Street, Hialeah, Florida 33016.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this Contract a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is PTP Coordinator, Mr. Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, Project Coordinator, for day-to-day responsibilities.

Background


As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contract process available under the MCC 7360 Program. Through this process, PWWM forwards a Request for Price Quotation by way of facsimile transmission to a pool of firms that have registered with the Internal Services Department for the respective trade. Additionally, PWWM advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM staff submitted its contract measure recommendation for Certified Small Business Enterprise participation on March 19, 2012. SBD completed its Project Review and Analysis process on March 20, 2012, and recommended a 1.67 percent subcontractor goal participation. A Community Workforce Program Goal is not applicable to this Contract. Subsequent to SBD's Project Review and Analysis, on April 5, 2012, PWWM forwarded the Request for Price Quotation for the PTP Traffic Signal Intersections Project, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08, to a list of 49 pre-registered firms. A total of six firms purchased contract documents, and five firms proffered a bid.

On May 9, 2012, AGC Electric, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive, responsible base bid of \$472,102.60, nineteen percent below the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, Statewide Electrical Services, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$496,525.00, five percent over the lowest bidder. The third lowest bidder, Under Power Corp. proffered a base bid of \$579,206.00, seventeen percent over the second lowest bidder. Based on the results of the solicitation, PWWM issued a recommendation for award on June 7, 2012 for RPQ No. 20120028 to AGC Electric, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC in accordance with PTP guidelines.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment and tools to perform all operations necessary for the installation of traffic signals, including any ancillary work at each specific location as indicated in the work orders. Traffic signalization upgrades include the installation of mastarm combinations, traffic controller assemblies, and the milling and resurfacing of affected roadways. Miami-Dade County will furnish the controller assembly at all new traffic signal installation locations, and the mastarms and anchor bolts for the SW 112 Avenue and SW 236 Street intersection.

The contractor shall furnish and install grounding electrodes, conduits, pull boxes, foundations, pedestrian signal heads with push buttons and signs, overhead signs, internally illuminated street name signs, mounting hardware, loop assemblies, signal cable, and solar school speed zone overhead flashing beacon assemblies. Furthermore, work includes the installation of pedestrian ramps, ground mounted signs, pavement markings, the construction of sidewalks, curbs and gutters, installation of truncated domes, and removing existing signs and traffic signalization devices in conflict with the proposed scope of work.


This letter will serve as your notification that you have been recommended for award for the above referenced RPQ based on your Price Quotation submitted on Wednesday, May 9, 2012. The total RPQ amount is for five hundred eighty thousand four hundred ninety-four dollars and ninety-one cents (\$580,494.91). This includes a base contract amount of four hundred seventy-two thousand one hundred two dollars and sixty cents (\$472,102.60), a contingency amount of forty-seven thousand two hundred ten dollars and twenty-six cents (\$47,210.26), and dedicated allowances totaling sixty-one thousand one hundred eighty-two dollars and five cents (\$61,182.05). The contract duration is established as 540-calendar days. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required in Contract No. MCC 7360 Plan, Section 2.0 Special Conditions, Page 16, Article 2.11, **PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**. (The original attached documents must be used and three (3) sets must be provided).
