

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A SIGNATURE LINE
ON ALL GOLDEN AND PATRIOT PASSPORTS ISSUED
AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREIN

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade Transit provides fare free transit service for Miami-Dade County residents aged sixty five and above and low-income honorably discharged veterans through the Golden and Patriot Passport programs; and

WHEREAS, the Golden and Patriot Passports include a photograph of the applicable transit rider; and

WHEREAS, providing a signature line on the actual Golden or Patriot Passport would deter fraud as well as provide a potentially convenient method of identification for Miami-Dade County residents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to provide a signature line on all Golden and Patriot Passports issued after the effective date of this Resolution.
