RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE NOVEMBER 29, 2012 "QUINCEANERAS FASHION SHOW" EVENT SPONSORED BY YOUTH CO-OP, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,400.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 12 FY 2012-13 IN-KIND BALANCE

WHEREAS, Youth Co-Op, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the November 29, 2012 "Quinceaneras Fashion Show" event in an amount not to exceed \$1,400.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "Quinceaneras Fashion Show" offers the local community an opportunity to, among other things, meet local elite vendors that cater social events such as "Sweet 15" parties; and

WHEREAS, the Youth Co-Op, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and


