It appeared to our satisfaction that the election was conducted among those qualified electors residing in the proposed special taxing district pursuant to the provisions of Section 18-3(f) of the Miami-Dade County Code and the Miami-Dade County Resolution calling for the special taxing district election.

We do hereby certify solely, exclusively and entirely from the ballots completed and returned to the Supervisor of Elections of Miami-Dade County, Florida on the issue of the special taxing district referenced in Ordinance #12-97 and Resolution R-979-12 adopted on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2012, that the results of the election were as follows:

Shall Ordinance No. 90-53 relating to Coventry Street Lighting Improvement Special Taxing District be amended to upgrade the street lighting lamp intensity from 9,500 lumen sodium vapor to 16,000 lumen sodium vapor and increase the number of street lighting facilities from 18 to 22, as provided for in County Ordinance No. 12-97?




