Subject: Supplemental Information for Resolution Waiving Competitive Bids for the Repairs of the Bear Cut Bridge and the West Bridge on the Rickenbacker Causeway

As a result of the repair work to the Bear Cut Bridge and the West Bridge on the Rickenbacker Causeway (Bridges), the existing water main attached to the Bridges needs to be relocated. The current pipe is attached to the old part of the bridge that will be repaired. The pipe will be relocated to the new part of the bridge and increased in size from the current 12 inches to 16 inches. The current water main was installed in 1968 and is nearing its life expectancy. The cost for this work is estimated at \$3 million and will be funded by the Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department. Once installed, the new water main will have a minimum 50 year life expectancy and will ensure that the pressure capacity for the pipes leading to the Village of Key Biscayne is maintained. This work increases the overall estimate for the project to \$28 million.
