## **Recommendation**

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Roadway Improvements along SW 27 Avenue from Tigertail Avenue to SW 28 Terrace – Phase II, located within Commission District 7* (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20120032) in the amount of \$4,303,889.81 to Williams Paving Co., Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the BCC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

## **Scope**

The work to be performed under this Contract includes roadway improvements along SW 27 Avenue from Tigertail Avenue to SW 28 Terrace, located within Commissioner Xavier L. Suarez' Commission District 7.

## **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$4,303,889.81 and will be funded in part from the Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds. The base contract amount is \$3,743,396.80, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. This site-specific project is included in the PTP Ordinance under the Board Requested Major Roadway and Neighborhood Improvement Projects in Commission District 7. The funding index code for this project is CPEPTP60727A (FY 2012-13 Adopted Capital Project 601260). Any other applicable funding source may subsidize the Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds allocated to this Contract.

The attached Memorandum of Agreement between the Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and PWWM funds the installation of water mains and appurtenances along the

project's limits of construction. The total cost for this work is \$734,266.65, which includes the contingency and dedicated allowances.

The annual estimated operations and maintenance costs for the PWWM portion of the work will be \$2,400.00 and \$8,630.00 respectively, and will be funded through PWWM's General Fund allocation. The annual operations and maintenance costs for the WASD portion of the work will be \$10,300.00 and \$4,700.00 respectively. The life expectancy for the roadway is approximately 30 years, and 50 years for the water main.

**Delegation of Authority**

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

**Track Record/Monitor**

Williams Paving Co., Inc. is currently performing work for PWWM at a satisfactory level. PWWM has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database and found nine (9) awarded construction contracts as follows:

- one (1) from the Public Housing and Community Development Department,
- one (1) from the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, and
- seven (7) from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of 13 contractor performance evaluations (several contracts having two evaluations on file, an interim and a project closeout) with an overall performance rating of 3.2 (satisfactory performance), out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. The Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Williams Paving Co., Inc., Company Principals are Jose Rodriguez, Alan B. Rodriguez, Ronnie L. Smith and Lonnie L. Collins and the Company's address is listed as 11300 NW South River Drive, Medley, Florida 33178.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this Contract a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is PTP Coordinator, Mr. Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Leo Salgueiro, Project Coordinator, for day-to-day responsibilities.

**Background**

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under the MCC 7360 Program. Through this process, PWWM forwards an RPQ, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of firms that have registered with the Internal Services Department for the respective trade. Additionally, PWWM advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM submitted to SBD its contract measure recommendation for Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) participation for this RPQ. SBD completed its Project Review and Analysis, and established a 25 percent CSBE Subcontractor Goal in the areas for Electrical, Concrete, and Traffic Stripes and Markings. A Community Workforce Program Goal was deemed not applicable to this RPQ. On October 11, 2012, PWWM forwarded an RPQ for the PTP Roadway Improvements along SW 27 Avenue, from Tigertail Avenue to SW 28 Terrace, Phase II, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Contract, to a list of 61 pre-qualified firms. A total of 16 firms purchased contract documents and four (4) firms proffered a bid.

On November 14, 2012, Williams Paving Co., Inc. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$3,743,396.80, five percent below the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, Acosta Tractors, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$3,953,417.75, six percent over the lowest bidder. The third lowest bidder, Central Florida Equipment Rentals, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$4,950,865.48, twenty-five percent over the second lowest bidder. The fourth lowest bidder, Bergeron Land Development, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$5,611,764.79, thirteen percent over the third lowest bidder. Based on the results of the solicitation, PWWM issued a Recommendation for Award on January 17, 2013 for RPQ No. 20120032 to Williams Paving Co., Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment, and tools to perform all operations necessary for the reconstruction of the existing two lane roadway with raised landscape medians, on-street parking, bike lanes, sidewalks, curb and gutters, storm drainage system, signalization, a traffic calming circle, pavement markings and signage, decorative lighting, and demolition of a building encroaching into the right-of-way.

The work also includes furnishing and installing ductile iron water mains along SW 27 Avenue between Tiger Tail Avenue and Coconut Avenue; furnishing and installing all ductile iron pipes and fittings, gate valves complete with riser pipe and valve box, nine (9) fire hydrant assemblies, 1-inch single short and long service connections, connections to existing water mains, air release valves and flushing water valves, cleaning, testing and disinfecting the mains, and all other appurtenant miscellaneous items and work for a complete and fully functional installation.

The contract duration is established as **560-calendar days**. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

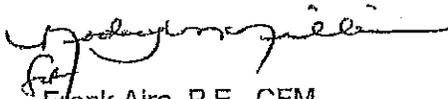

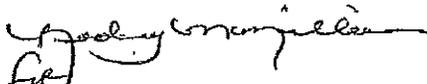

Small Business Development (SBD), under Business Affairs, a Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources has completed its review of the subject project for compliance with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program for Construction Services. The contract measure established for this project is a 25% CSBE Subcontractor Goal.

The Contracts & Specifications Section of the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWMD) has submitted bid documents from Williams Paving Co., Inc. Williams Paving Co., Inc. (#1), submitted a Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing utilize the following CSBE certified firms: Bennett Electrical Services Co. to perform signal and lighting work at 13%; J & M Parking Lot Maintenance, Inc. to perform pavement markings and signage work at 11%; and Pilome Engineering, Inc. to perform underground work at 64%. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Williams Paving Co., Inc. is in compliance with the Implementing Order for the CSBE Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

Acosta Tractors (#2), submitted SOI Affidavits committing to utilize the following CSBE certified firms: Bennett Electrical Services Co. to perform lighting and signalization work at 10%; Jack's Concrete Services to perform concrete work at 13.5%; and P& J Striping to perform striping work at 1.5%. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Acosta Tractors is in compliance with the Implementing Order for the CSBE Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

Central Florida Equipment Rentals, Inc. (#3), submitted an SOI Affidavit committing to utilize HI-Tech Concrete, a certified CSBE firm, to perform concrete work at 8.11%. Pursuant to the I.O. for the CSBE Program bidders whose bids do not meet the specified goal and who do not prove lack of availability as indicated in Section 2(g) on the I.O. are not in compliance.

**Memorandum of Agreement Between the Public Works and Water and Sewer Departments of Miami-Dade County for Water and Sewer Utilities and Road Improvements Along SW 27 Avenue between Tigertail Avenue and SW 28<sup>th</sup> Terrace.**

The execution of this Memorandum of Agreement represents the desire between Miami-Dade County Public Works Department (PWD) and Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) to enter into a joint project agreement to install water mains and appurtenances along SW 27 Avenue from Tigertail Avenue to SW 28<sup>th</sup> Terrace as part of a PWD road improvement project along the same location.

This Memorandum of Agreement, when approved and accepted by both Directors of the Departments, shall set forth the terms and conditions under which said water and sewer main installations and construction be administered, performed, paid and executed, as follows:

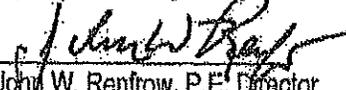
1. PWD will perform a final review of the WASD design documents. WASD will also review the PWD design documents. Conflicts will be discussed and modifications made to accommodate the work of both departments. WASD and PWD design documents will be jointly incorporated into the official Miami-Dade County construction contract documents.
2. PWD and WASD will jointly coordinate the Maintenance of Traffic (M.O.T.) and Construction Schedules for this project. The M.O.T. will provide for two (2) lanes of traffic to be maintained at all times and no interruption of existing water and sewer services to the existing properties affected by the project.
3. WASD will provide PWD with its Bid Plans, Technical Specifications and Special Provisions for the water mains. These specifications and provisions shall be incorporated into the County's construction contract documents and enforced by the PWD project manager and WASD project inspector.
4. PWD will administer the project from bid notification to contract completion. WASD will review all utility related bid tabulation to determine the equitability and acceptance of the bid as it relates to the utility installation within the PWD time requirements. PWD will conduct and administer a Pre-Bid meeting for all contractors who are interested in submitting bids. WASD shall provide an Engineer of Record for the utility portion of the project for consultation on any technical changes.
5. The bid form will be divided into two sections, grouped by PWD bid items and WASD bid items. Bid Items that affect both work segments will be identified and allocated by mutual agreement in writing and approved by both Department Directors.
6. In the event the lowest bidder's cost for the utility installation portion of the project is substantially higher than the budgeted utility cost, and WASD decides not to proceed with

the utility installation, the PWD roadway project shall continue independently and without interruption.

7. PWD will administer the entire construction phase of the project. WAsD will provide an on-site project manager and/or inspector to work with the PWD project manager to oversee the utility installation and ensure that the utility installation is performed in accordance with WAsD specifications and standards, which include but is not limited to; installation, pressure testing and certification of the WAsD facilities and as-builts submittal. It is understood that the entire project will be managed in such a manner that it will not be a detriment to each Department's portion of contract work and with the County's best interest in mind at all times.
8. WAsD shall have the right to review and approve any design deviations, requests for information and other technical issues prior to any field changes for the utility installation portion of the project. WAsD will provide extra funding to cover any design deviations for the utility installation portion and will provide timely approval of deviations.
9. WAsD will require that the installed utility lines be tested in accordance with the prescribed WAsD specification before any additional installation is continued. This requirement will be included in the WAsD specifications that will be provided to PWD to be incorporated in the contract documents and sequence of construction and overall contract duration.
10. PWD and WAsD will address, process and approve any time extensions, additional work, claims or change orders which arise within the scope of this project. PWD shall consult WAsD in all additional work, claims or change orders related to the utility installation prior to agreeing to any such additional work, claims or change orders. PWD shall incorporate WAsD in its written approval process as it relates to time extensions, extra work, claims or change orders generated by the utility installation. WAsD will actively participate and comply with the entire PWD approval process, requirements and procedures.
11. The PWD contractor shall provide complete and certified as-builts to WAsD in the prescribed manner as required in the WAsD Technical Specification. PWD shall not release any payment, including the final payment that will prejudice the preparation of the as-builts until WAsD has approved and accepted the as-builts.
12. WAsD shall transmit the funds for the cost of the utility installations to PWD based upon the issuance of the Recommendation of Award to the successful bidder, plus 2% of the Base Contract Amount for administrative costs of tabulation of quantities, final bid processing and project accounting (said amounts are to be hereinafter collectively referred to as the Allowances) and field work; plus 10% of the Base Contract Amount for contingency fund to be used as hereinafter provided for changes to the utility work during the construction of the project (also known as the Contingency Fund); plus 2% of the Base Contract Amount for Permit Fees and plus 3% of the Base Contract Amount for the Maintenance of Traffic. Any unused monies allocated for the WAsD bid items portion, Allowances, Contingency Fund, Administrative Costs, Permit Fees and Maintenance of Traffic shall be returned to WAsD upon completion of the Public Works project.

13. All issues that arise while executing this project will be resolved with the County's best interest in mind.
