A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF MIAMI'S ("CITY'S") EFFORTS TO GAIN CONTROL FROM MIAMI-DADE COUNTY OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO SPEED BUMPS, ON NON-ARTERIAL CITY ROADS; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE OFFICIALS STATED HEREIN.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Miami City Commission hereby supports the City of Miami's ("City's") efforts to gain control from Miami-Dade County of traffic control devices, including, but not limited to speed bumps, on non-arterial City roads.

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to Mayor Carlos Gimenez, the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners and to the Miami-Dade Transportation Department.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}

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Footnotes:

{1} If the Mayor does not sign this Resolution, it shall become effective at the end of ten calendar days from the date it was passed and adopted. If the Mayor vetoes this Resolution, it shall become effective immediately upon override of the veto by the City Commission.
