

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO NOTIFY THE CHAIRPERSON AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' CULTURAL AFFAIRS & RECREATION COMMITTEE OF CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION

WHEREAS, a Cultural Affairs & Recreation Committee has been established under Rule 4.01(a) of the Board of County Commissioners' Rules of Procedure to oversee all matters pertaining to parks, libraries, museums, and cultural facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Affairs & Recreation Committee has jurisdiction over the Cultural Affairs Department; Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources—Historic Preservation; Miami-Dade Public Library System; Museum and Cultural Facilities; and Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department; and

WHEREAS, each of these departments benefit from the receipt of public funds for capital construction projects that are of major significance to the Miami-Dade County community and its visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Chairperson and Members of the Cultural Affairs & Recreation Committee are a valuable point of contact and source of information for members of the public interested in the activities and accomplishments of the departments under the Committee's purview; and

WHEREAS, public awareness of the capital construction projects spearheaded by the departments under the Committee's purview would be augmented by events such as groundbreakings and ceremonial openings at new or improved cultural and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, advance notice of capital construction project commencement and completion would facilitate the Chairperson and Members' ability to organize groundbreaking and ceremonial opening events,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to give the Chairperson and Members of the Cultural Affairs & Recreation Committee at least thirty (30) days' notice in advance of the commencement or completion of a capital construction project by any department under the jurisdiction of the Cultural Affairs & Recreation Committee.
