Subject: Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (February 2013)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report for all Transit modes during the month of February 2013.

For the reporting period of February 2013, overall system average daily ridership was up 4.5% when compared to the February 2012 period. The biggest increase was in our Metrorail mode where the increase over the prior year was 11.2%; followed by Metromover with a 5.6% increase, Metrobus at a 2.7% increase and Special Transportation Services (STS) at a 2.1% increase.

Specifically, when compared to the prior year, the largest increases in average weekday boarding's at certain Metrorail Stations are shown in the below chart:
