Ordinance No. 13-29, adopted on April 2, 2013, requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to complete background research on any person, organization, place or thing that is the subject of a naming, re-naming or co-designation item.

In accordance with the Ordinance we are providing this report as a supplement to BCC Agenda Item 5(A).

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 13-29, the OCA completed background research regarding BCC Agenda Item 5(A), Resolution re-naming Bicentennial Park Metromover Station as Museum Park Metromover Station and there were no adverse findings.

On July 25, 2002, the City of Miami through Resolution No. 02-862, designated "Museum Park Miami" as the official design vision for Bicentennial Park.

On March 15, 2011, the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners through Resolution No. 195-11, approved the plat of Museum Park.
