Subject: Resolution Approving a Modification to a Contract with Siemens Industry Inc. Related to the County's Building Management System

Agenda Item No. 8(F)(3)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) waive competitive bidding procedures for the purchase of goods and services pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Section 5.03(D) of the Home Rule Charter and approve the attached modification to an existing sole source contract. The item is described briefly below and in more detail in the accompanying attachment.

Item 1 – Building Management System, Maintenance - Modifies this contract for additional spending authority in the amount of \$1,098,000 for continued preventative and corrective maintenance, component replacement, software upgrades, and diagnostic testing services to the existing Siemens Building Management System for various County departments.

Scope

The scope of the contract modification in this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The allocations and funding sources for the departments utilizing this contract are listed in detail in the attached item.

The contract amount and departmental allocations represent the maximum spending authority based on past utilization. This action does not guarantee that the total contract amount/value will be expended by each department. Funding will be expended only if the department's budget can support the expenditures approved in its annual budget adopted by the Board.

Track Record/Monitor

There are no known performance/compliance issues with the vendor recommended for award in the attached item. Each departments' contract manager is reflected in the item.

Delegated Authority

If this item is approved, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to extend the contracts for purchase of goods and services in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contracts listed in the attached items.

Due Diligence

Due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine Contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status and review of performance or compliance issues. The lists that were referenced include: convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There

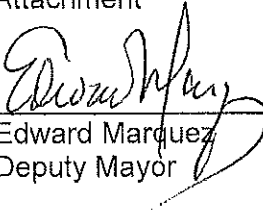

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF FORMAL BID PROCEDURES BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3S) VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT TO AUTHORIZE MODIFICATION OF A CONTRACT WITH SIEMENS INDUSTRY INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS AND SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$1,098,000.00

WHEREAS, the County Mayor recommends to this Board to waive formal bid procedures for the purchase of goods and services which cannot be purchased under normal bid procedures,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board waives formal bid procedures, pursuant to Section 5.03(D) of the Home Rule Charter and Section 2-8.1 of the County Code by a two-thirds (2/3s) vote of the members present.

Section 2. This Board authorizes the modification of a contract with Siemens Industry Inc. as set forth in Item 1 of the incorporated memorandum to add an additional \$1,098,000.00 of spending authority for the purchase of goods and services.

Section 3. This Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute contracts for the items approved herein and exercise contract modifications, options-to-renew, any cancellation provisions, and any other rights contained therein in accordance with the terms and conditions of such contracts.

Contract Description and Reason for Change:

This contract is for preventative and corrective maintenance, component replacement, software upgrades, and diagnostic testing services for the Siemens Building Management System (BMS) installed at various County facilities. Additional allocation of \$1,098,000 is being requested for the following:

- Includes funding for the remaining three years of this contract to cover maintenance services at nine new locations that have been added since the original adoption of this contract.
- Equipment upgrades at the Dade County Courthouse and Hickman Administration Building that will allow the Internal Services Department to shift system monitoring from a physical to a virtual service, thus providing redundancy in the event of major power outages, server crashes, and/or hurricane damage.
- New services such as mandated periodic smoke tests and the addition of equipment and monitored devices at the Stephen P. Clark Center, Central Support Facility, and the Miami-Dade Cultural Center, all of which are required as a result of the recently completed installation of new fire alarm and building management control systems in the three facilities.

The BMS provides a one-source management application to ensure the safety and security of the people utilizing County facilities and for the facilities themselves.
