Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Roadway Improvements along SW 17 Avenue, from South Dixie Highway to West Flagler Street, located within Commission District 5* (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20120127) in the amount of \$1,127,884.06 to H & J Asphalt, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the BCC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract includes roadway improvements along SW 17 Avenue, from South Dixie Highway to West Flagler Street, located within Bruno Barreiro's Commission District 5.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$1,127,884.06 and will be funded from the Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds, and Joint Participation Agreement with the City of Miami approved under BCC Resolution No. R-793-12 on October 2, 2012. The base contract amount is \$968,200.05, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. This site-specific project is included in the PTP Ordinance under the Board Requested Major Roadway and Neighborhood Improvement Projects in Commission District 5. The funding index code for this project is CPEPTP605RWN (FY 2012-13 Adopted Capital Project 6037700). Any other applicable funding source may subsidize the Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds allocated to this Contract.

The annual estimated operations and maintenance costs for the roadway work will be approximately \$10,300.00 and \$10,157.60 respectively, and will be funded through PWWM's General Fund allocation. The life expectancy for the roadway is approximately 30 years.

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

Track Record/Monitor

H & J Asphalt, Inc. is currently performing work for PWWM at a satisfactory level. PWWM has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database and found 34 awarded construction contracts as follows:

- one (1) from the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, and
- 33 from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of 82 contractor performance evaluations (several contracts having two evaluations on file, an interim and a project closeout) with an overall performance rating of 3.1 (satisfactory performance), out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. The Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, H & J Asphalt, Inc., Company Principals are Humberto Lorenzo and Jorge Lorenzo and the Company's address is listed as 4310 NW 35 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33142.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this Contract a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is PTP Coordinator, Mr. Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Joaquin Rabassa, P.E., Project Coordinator, for day-to-day responsibilities.

Background

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under the MCC 7360 Program. Through this process, PWWM forwards an RPQ, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of firms that have registered with the Internal Services Department for the respective trade. Additionally, PWWM advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM submitted to SBD its contract measure recommendation for Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) participation for this RPQ. SBD completed its Project Review and Analysis, and established CSBE Trade Set-Asides for Electrical and Traffic Stripes and Markings. A Community Workforce Program Goal of 21.80 percent has been established for this project since the project location falls within a Designated Target Area.

On December 20, 2012, PWWM forwarded an RPQ for the PTP Roadway Improvements along SW 17 Avenue, from South Dixie Highway to West Flagler Street, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Contract, to a list of 62 pre-qualified firms. A total of three (3) firms purchased contract documents and five (5) firms proffered a bid.

On January 25, 2013, H & J Asphalt, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$968,200.05, eleven percent below the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, Metro Express, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$1,037,302.95, seven percent over the lowest bidder. The third lowest bidder, Williams Paving Company, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$1,210,486.33, 17 percent over the second lowest bidder. The fourth lowest bidder, H & R Paving, Inc. proffered a base bid of \$1,252,006.65, three percent over the third lowest bidder. The fifth lowest bidder, Kailas, Corp. proffered a base bid of \$1,444,009.61, 15 percent over the fourth lowest bidder. Based on the results of the solicitation, PWWM issued a Recommendation for Award on February 13, 2013 for RPQ No. 20120127 to H & J Asphalt, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment, and tools to perform all operations necessary for the reconstruction of the existing roadway with milling, resurfacing, signage and pavement markings, pedestrian ramp installation, raised landscape medians, loop assembly replacement, and solar pedestrian flashing lights.



This letter will serve as your notification that you have been recommended for award for the above referenced RPQ based on your Price Quotation submitted on Friday, January 25, 2013. The total RPQ amount is for one million one hundred twenty-seven thousand eight hundred eighty-four dollars and six cents (\$1,127,884.06). This includes a base contract amount of nine hundred sixty-eight thousand two hundred dollars and five cents (\$968,200.05), a contingency amount of ninety-six thousand eight hundred twenty dollars and one cent (\$96,820.01), and dedicated allowances totaling sixty-two thousand eight hundred sixty-four dollars and zero cents (\$62,864.00). The contract duration is established as **180-calendar days**. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required in Contract No. MCC 7360 Plan, Section 2.0 Special Conditions, Page 16, Article 2.11, **PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**. (The original attached documents must be used and three (3) sets must be provided).
2. Letter from Bonding Agent granting Miami-Dade County authorization to date the Performance Bond.
3. Copies of current insurance certificates.
4. Copies of required license(s).

The preceding documents are required as outlined within Contract MCC 7360 Plan and to be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the document(s) within the specified time, or any extension granted, will result in the award being rescinded.

Subsequent to the review and approval of the aforementioned documents, you are required to obtain the required permits in the time stipulated in the RPQ. Upon obtaining the permit(s) a copy(s) must be submitted to the Project Manager prior to commencement of work.



Small Business Development (SBD), under Business Affairs, a Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources has completed its review of the subject project for compliance with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program for Construction Services. The contract measure established for this project is a 21.8% Community Workforce Program (CWP) Goal and two (2) Trade Set-Asides in the following trade areas:

Trade Set-Aside #1 - Traffic Stripes and Markings: Painted and/or Thermoplastic

Trade Set-Aside #2 – Electrical (Inductive Loop Detectors)

The Contracts & Specifications Section of the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWMD) has submitted bid documents from H & J Asphalt, Inc. (#1), Metro Express (#2), and Williams Paving Co., Inc. (#3) for compliance review. Following is the pre-award compliance status and summary.

SUMMARY:

H & J Asphalt, Inc. (#1), submitted Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavits committing utilize the following CSBE certified firms: Miami Striping, Inc., Inc. to perform Traffic Stripes and Markings: Painted and/or Thermoplastic and Florida Sol System to perform Electrical (Inductive Loop Detectors) work. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. H & J Asphalt, Inc. is in compliance with the Implementing Order for the CSBE Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

Metro Express, Inc. (#2), submitted Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavits committing to utilize the following CSBE certified firms: Road Runner Striping Technologies, Inc. to perform Traffic Stripes and Markings: Painted and/or Thermoplastic and Florida Sol System to perform Electrical (Inductive Loop Detectors) work. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Metro Express has a goal deficit make-up balance in the amount of \$78,760.05 for Project No. 630022. However, Metro Express, Inc. did not submit a goal deficit make-up plan at the time of bid submittal as required pursuant to Ordinance No. 09-41 amending the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) program, §10-33-02 of the Code of Miami Dade County, to require a contractor with a pending CSBE make-up to

submit a make-up plan and corresponding Schedule of Intent Affidavit (SOI) as part of any bid or proposal submitted for future contracts at the time of bid or proposal submittal. As such, Metro Express, Inc. is non-responsive to the Implementing Order for the CSBE Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

Williams Paving Company, Inc. (#3) submitted an SOI Affidavit committing to utilize Hurricane Irrigation, Inc., a non-certified CSBE firm, to perform landscape and irrigation work. The required SOI Affidavits were not submitted identifying a certified CSBE firm to perform the Traffic Stripes and Markings: Painted and/or Thermoplastic and Electrical (Inductive Loop Detectors) scopes of work. SBD notified Williams Paving Company, Inc. in writing that their bid documents submitted did not comply with the CSBE measures established for this project. The firm did not request a meeting to provide additional documentation and clarification to assist in the compliance review. As such, Williams Paving Company, Inc. is not in compliance with the Implementing Order for the CSBE Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

Please note that SBD staff reviewed and addressed compliance with the CSBE program. The Contracts & Specifications Section of the PWWMD is responsible for any other issues that may exist.


