

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH  
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF WEST 1ST  
AVENUE FROM WEST 5TH STREET TO WEST 6TH STREET  
AS "WOMAN'S CLUB AVENUE"

**WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2013, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah adopted Resolution No. 13-17 which codesignated that portion of West 1st Avenue from West 5th Street to West 6th Street as "Woman's Club Avenue," in recognition of the contributions of the GFWC Woman's Club of Hialeah to the betterment of the community in the City of Hialeah through its volunteer services, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Federation of Women's Clubs has been a unifying force, bringing together local women's clubs from around the country and throughout the world; and

**WHEREAS**, although there is considerable diversity in the ages, interests, and experiences of the clubwomen of the General Federation of Women's Clubs, all are united by a dedication to community improvement through volunteer service; and

**WHEREAS**, during its first century the General Federation of Women's Clubs had many accomplishments, including establishing 75 percent of the country's public libraries, developing kindergartens in the public schools, and working for food and drug regulation; and

**WHEREAS**, during its second century, the General Federation of Women's Clubs has pledged to maintain its commitment to working for a better world and, with its "Unity in Diversity" motto and a strong umbrella of programs that clubs may adapt to suit the needs of their communities, the General Federation of Women's Clubs encourages the flexibility that has enabled it to expand its reach in a rapidly changing society; and

**WHEREAS**, the GFWC Woman’s Club of Hialeah has exemplified the mission and values of the General Federation of Women’s Clubs by providing opportunities for education, leadership, training, and community service to both members and non-members alike on local, state, national, and global levels; and

**WHEREAS**, that portion of West 1st Avenue from West 5th Street to West 6th Street is a city street located in the City of Hialeah; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

**WHEREAS**, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the City of Hialeah codesignation of that portion of West 1st Avenue from West 5th Street to West 6th Street as “Woman’s Club Avenue.”

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, the Hialeah Police Department and the Hialeah Fire Department.
