**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 92ND AVENUE BETWEEN SW
40TH STREET AND SW 24TH STREET AS "REPUBLICA ARGENTINA
AVENUE"**

Ordinance No. 13-29, adopted on April 2, 2013, requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to complete background research on any person, organization, place or thing that is the subject of a naming, re-naming or co-designation item.

In accordance with the Ordinance, we are providing this report as a supplement to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) Agenda Item 5(O).

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 13-29, the OCA completed background research regarding BCC Agenda Item 5(O), Resolution co-designating SW 92nd Avenue between SW 40th Street and SW 24th Street as "Republica Argentina Way" and there were no adverse findings.

On November 6, 2001, the BCC, through Resolution No. R-1227-01, established a Sister City Program between Miami-Dade County and the Province of Mendoza, Argentina.

On July 19, 2011, the BCC, through Resolution No. R-623-11, urged the federal government to extend visa waiver status to Argentina, Brazil, Chile and urged Congress to pass the Secure Travel & Counterterrorism Partnership Program Act of 2011 or similar legislation.
