Subject: Resolution Declaring the Acquisition of the Designated Property Known as Parcel 101 for Right-of-Way Needed for the PTP Project Entitled Improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street to be a Public Necessity and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution which does the following:

- Declares the acquisition of Parcel 101 required for the road widening, beautification, and right-of-way improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street to be a public necessity; and
- Authorizes the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee and the County Attorney to employ appraisers, expert witnesses, obtain required environmental audits, and to take any and all appropriate actions to acquire the subject parcel in fee simple, either by negotiation, donation, purchase at values established by appraisals or tax assessed value whichever is the higher of the two, together with reasonable attorneys' fees and costs pursuant to Chapters 73.091 and 73.092, Florida Statutes, or eminent domain court proceedings including a declaration of taking as necessary for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County.

This resolution is for the acquisition of Parcel 101 which is needed for programmed improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street. It is anticipated that the entire project will consist of approximately 47 parcels of which 46 are being presented separately for BCC consideration on this agenda. Florida Statute Section 127.02 requires that there be a separate resolution adopted for each individual property.

Said Resolution is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This item may only be considered by the BCC if the CITT has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this item. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this item, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

The impact of this project is countywide; however, it is located within Commissioner Lynda Bell's District 8.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

Funding for the right-of-way acquisition, design and construction of this Project is from Charter County Transportation Surtax bond proceeds, and may be supplemented by other eligible funding sources. Funding is programmed within the adopted FY2010-11 Capital Budget and the index code is CPEPTP608US1. The initial acquisition cost has been

budgeted and no additional fiscal impacts are expected; however, in the event of litigation the ultimate acquisition cost would be subject to a future ruling by the Court.

The total cost of the project (inclusive of construction, design and the right-of-way acquisition of all parcels) is estimated at \$17,706,777.52. The anticipated ongoing annual maintenance and operational costs will be approximately \$51,865.00 and \$17,064.00, respectively.


Track Record/Monitor

Glass Land Acquisition Service Specialists, Inc. is responsible for acquiring the right of way for this project and Francisco Fernandez, Chief Real Estate Officer, from Public Works and Waste Management (PWWM) is monitoring the process.

Background

PWWM has programmed the construction of SW 137 Avenue as part of the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street. The proposed project includes roadway expansion, beautification and improvements consisting of a new two-lane road including sidewalks, curb and gutter, a continuous storm drainage system, signalization, pavement markings and signage, street lighting, bicycle facilities, a bridge crossing over one (1) canal and a culvert for a second canal.

The area to be acquired by Miami-Dade County is necessary for the proposed roadway improvements, and is legally described in "Exhibit A" and illustrated on the parcel location map in "Exhibit B 1 of 2" and "Exhibit B 2 of 2" all attached herewith.

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF THE DESIGNATED PROPERTY KNOWN AS PARCEL 101 FOR THE PEOPLE'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN (PTP) PROJECT ENTITLED IMPROVEMENTS ON SW 137 AVENUE FROM US-1 TO SW 200 STREET, TO BE A PUBLIC NECESSITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE AND THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO TAKE ANY AND ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO ACCOMPLISH ACQUISITION OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IN FEE SIMPLE, BY DONATION, PURCHASE AT VALUES ESTABLISHED BY APPRAISALS OR TAX ASSESSED VALUE WHICHEVER IS THE HIGHER OF THE TWO TOGETHER WITH REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 73.091 AND 73.092, FLORIDA STATUTES, OR BY EMINENT DOMAIN COURT PROCEEDING INCLUDING DECLARATIONS OF TAKING, AS NECESSARY; AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CHARTER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SURTAX FUNDS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board ratifies and adopts these matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. This Board finds and declares that the acquisition of the subject parcel, as legally described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is needed for the public purpose of improvements to SW 137 Avenue from US-1 to SW 200 Street.

Section 3. This Board authorizes and directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee and County Attorney to employ appraisers, review appraisers and expert witnesses, to

obtain required environmental audits and to take any action to acquire the subject parcel, as legally described in "Exhibit A" in fee simple, including any businesses thereon, either by donation, purchase at values established by appraisals or tax assessed value whichever is the higher of the two together with reasonable attorneys' fees, expert fees and costs pursuant to Chapter 73.091 and 73.092, Florida Statutes, or eminent domain court proceedings including a declaration of taking as necessary for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County and authorizes the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds.

Section 4. Pursuant to Resolution No. R-974-09, this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to record the instruments of conveyance accepted herein in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and to provide a recorded copy of the instrument to the Clerk of the Board within thirty (30) days of execution of said instrument; and directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy together with this resolution.

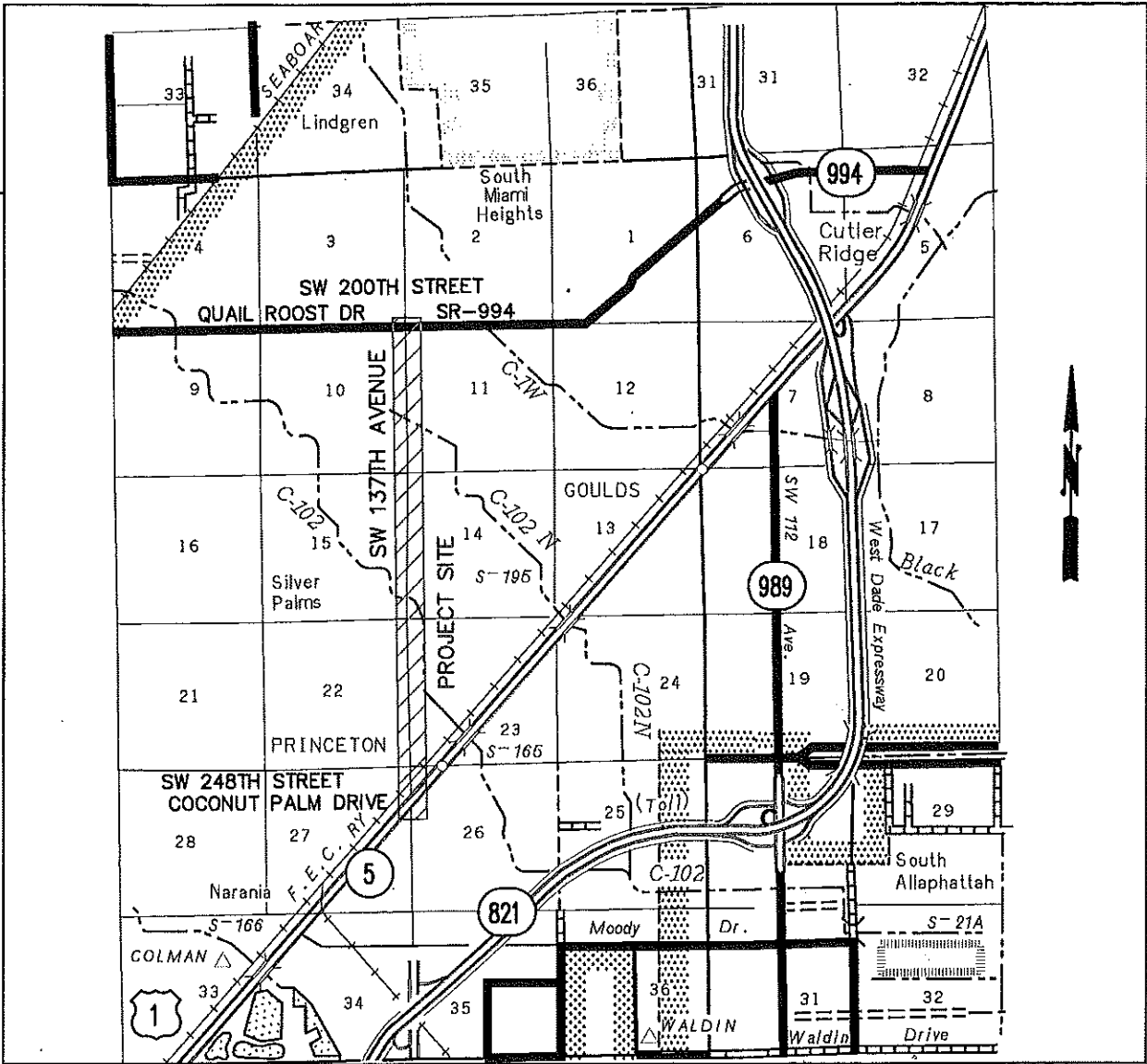
