Subject: Resolution Authorizing Competitive Contract Modifications and Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached competitive contract modifications with authority to exercise options-to-renew (OTRs). The items are described below and in more detail in the accompanying attachments. The total additional funding requested for the contracts listed is \$257,000.

Item 1 – Batteries – Alkaline and General Purpose: Modifies this contract by \$50,000 in spending authority to add a five-year allocation for Miami-Dade Transit (MDT). MDT will use this contract for the purchase of alkaline and general purpose batteries.

Item 2 – Rental of Portable Chemical Toilets: Modifies this contract for an additional \$3,000 in spending authority so MDT can continue renting portable chemical toilets through the end of the contract term in November 2013.

Item 3 – Uniforms, Rental, Purchase and Laundry Services: Modifies this contract for an additional six months and \$185,000 in spending authority so MDT can continue to rent uniforms and obtain laundry services for bus maintenance supervisors, bus hostlers, technicians, stock clerks, and vehicle mechanics.

Item 4 – Work Gloves: Modifies this contract for an additional \$19,000 in spending authority so MDT can continue purchasing work gloves through the end of the contract term in November 2013.

Section 29-124 of the Code requires all contracts, funded by People's Transportation Plan Surtax proceeds, regardless of value, to be approved by the Citizen's Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) and the Board. This package is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). These recommendations may only be considered by the Board if the CITT has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item. The contracts in this package are scheduled for the June 2013 CITT meeting.

Scope

The impact of the items is countywide in nature.

If the items in this package are approved, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise, in their discretion, subsequent options-to-renew periods and extend contracts for purchase of goods and services in accordance with the terms and conditions of each contract.

Due Diligence

Due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine Contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status and review of performance or compliance issues. The lists referenced include convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There were no adverse findings relating to Contractor responsibility. This information is provided pursuant to R-187-12.

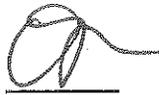
