## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) withdraw legislative item No. 121943 for the Contract Award Recommendation to Brailly Electric Corp. (Brailly) for Project MCC 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07, RPQ No. 20120077, and reject all bids received as part of this solicitation in order to re-advertise the project and meet PWWM's goal of completing the installation of internally illuminated street name signs along key corridors throughout the County.

## Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract included illuminated street name sign installations at various locations within Miami-Dade County.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact was approximately \$166,592.00 and to be funded from the Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds. The base contract amount was \$137,640.00, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

The proposed improvements qualified under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for traffic signs is included under Traffic Signals and Signs Operations in the PTP Countywide Neighborhood Improvements. The funding index code for this Project was CPEPTP600SGN.99111.

## Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

## Track Record/Monitor

Brailly Electric Corp. is currently performing work for PWWM at an outstanding level. PWWM has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database and found twelve (12) awarded construction contracts as follows:

- one (1) from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department,
- one (1) from the Public Housing and Community Development Department,
- one (1) from the Seaport and
- nine (9) from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of 13 contractor performance evaluations with an exemplary performance rating of 4.0 (superior performance). The Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Brailly Electric Corp., Company Principals are: Hector N. Brailly and Guillermo J. Brailly and the Company's address is listed as: 10000 East Calusa Club Drive, Miami, Florida 33186.

**Background**

The project was advertised on July 5, 2012 under the 7040 Miscellaneous Construction Contract Program, to which Brailly proffered the lowest, responsive and responsible bid on August 3, 2012. As this project is funded by the People's Transportation Plan (PTP), the award of the contract was subject to the approval of the Citizen's Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) and the BCC. The project was passed by the Regional Transportation Committee on October 15, 2012, was approved by the CITT on October 19, 2012, and was before the BCC for consideration on November 8, 2012; however, the legislative item was deferred due to concerns raised by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local Union. PWWM met with International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers representatives and subsequently investigated concerns regarding bidders meeting Miami-Dade County's business licensing requirements (e.g., Certificates of Occupancy and Certificates of Use). PWWM worked with the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department and the County Attorney's Office, and found that Brailly did not hold a Certificate of Use for the use of a Home Office. However, it was determined that this did not impact their status as a certified Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) contractor, nor did it affect the responsiveness or responsibility of their bid. Subsequent to being notified, Brailly has obtained the Certificate of Use for a Home Office.

Given the time since bids were received, Brailly has requested to be released from the project on account of being notified by suppliers that prices for materials have risen. Rather than placing a CSBE contractor in a position where they may not be able to deliver services to the County, PWWM recommends that this project be cancelled, all bids be rejected, and the project be re-advertised.



## Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Internally Illuminated Street Name Sign Installation* (Project MCO 7040 Plan - CICC 7040-0/07 Request for Price Quotation No. 20120077) in the amount of \$166,592.00 to Brally Electric Corp., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BOC).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the BOC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BOC prior to the date scheduled for BOC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

## Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract includes illuminated street name sign installations at various locations within Miami-Dade County.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$166,592.00 and will be funded from the Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds. The base contract amount is \$137,640.00, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for traffic signs is included under Traffic Signals and Signs Operations in the PTP Countywide Neighborhood Improvements. The funding Index code for this project is CPEPTP600SGN.99111.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is PTP Coordinator, Mr. Alejandro Martínez-Estévez, RA, LEED AP. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, Project Manager, for day to day responsibilities.

#### Background

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under the MCC 7040 Program. Through this process, PWWM forwards a Request for Price Quotation, by way of facsimile transmission, to a pool of pre-qualified Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) contractors for the subject trade. Additionally, PWWM advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM staff determined that the scope of work for this project qualified for a CSBE set-aside (Levels I, II, and III). In addition, a Community Workforce Program Goal of ten (10) percent has been established for this project as several work locations fall within a Designated Target Area. On July 6, 2012, PWWM forwarded RPQ No. 20120077, utilizing the MCC 7040 Plan - CJC 7040-0/07 Contract to a list of 45 pre-qualified firms. A total of four (4) firms purchased contract documents and three (3) firms proffered a bid.

On August 3, 2012, Brally Electric Corp. proffered the lowest responsive, responsible base bid of \$197,640.00, two (2) percent above the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, Solares Electrical Services, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$212,290.40, 54 percent over the lowest bidder. The third lowest bidder, Florida Sol Systems, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$260,092.80, 23 percent over the second lowest bidder.

Based on the results of the solicitation, PWAM issued a recommendation for award on August 14, 2012, for RPO No. 20120077 to Brally Electric Corp., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the BCC.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, tools and equipment required to provide the installation of internally illuminated street name signs at designated sites within Miami-Dade County. The work includes sign installation as well as the removal of existing overhead signs, and the relocation of existing signal heads and signs in conflict with this proposed scope of work as directed by the Engineer.
