**Subject:** Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (June 2013)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for June 2013.

For the reporting period, overall system average daily ridership was up 4.2% from the June 2012 period. The biggest increase was in our Metrorail mode, where boardings were up 18.4% over the prior year; this was followed by Metromover, at 10.1%, and Special Transportation Services (STS), at 2.7%.

Specifically, the largest percentage increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from June 2012 to June 2013, were realized at the following stations:

In addition, the largest growth in average weekday Metrorail boardings from June 2012 to June 2013 occurred at the following stations:
