WHEREAS, this Board recognizes promoting responsible pet ownership and reducing animal overpopulation as important public policies; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Animal Services Department has prepared educational materials, including a video available online at

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (MDCPS) is incorporating animal care education in the elementary school curriculum for third, fourth, and fifth grades; and

WHEREAS, MDCPS has requested the Animal Services Department's participation in developing and implementing its animal education curriculum; and

WHEREAS, this Board supports the efforts of Miami-Dade County Public Schools to educate children about responsible pet ownership and animal care,
