SUBJECT: RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 80 STREET FROM SW 107 AVENUE TO SW 114 AVENUE AS "PEDRO PAN STREET"

Ordinance No. 13-29, adopted on April 2, 2013, requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to complete background research on any person, organization, place or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming or codesignation item.

In accordance with the Ordinance, we are providing this report as a supplement to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) Agenda Item 5B.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 13-29, the OCA completed background research regarding BCC Agenda Item 5B, Resolution codesignating SW 80 Street from SW 107 Avenue to SW 114 Avenue as "Pedro Pan Street" and there were no adverse findings.

The BCC has previously approved the following resolutions with regards to Operation Pedro Pan:

December 4, 2012	R-995-12 ¹	Resolution codesignating West 12 Avenue from West 37 Street to West 49 Street as "Operation Pedro Pan Avenue"; Urging the City of Hialeah to join in this codesignation.
October 23, 2012	R-862-12	Resolution approving the City of Miami codesignation of Southeast 15 Road from Brickell Avenue to Biscayne Bay as "Elly Chovel Road."
December 7, 2002	R-1432-02 ²	Resolution codesignating SW 120 Street from SW 137 Avenue to SW 147 Avenue as Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street.

¹ On January 23, 2013, the BCC, through R-49-13, amended R-995-12, for the purpose of changing the codesignation from being from West 37 Street to West 49 Street to being from West 44 Place to West 49 Street at the request of the City of Hialeah.

² On May 6, 2003, the BCC, through R-498-03, amended R-1432-02, to include SW 120 Street from 117 Avenue to SW 147 Avenue.
