RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF NW 59TH
AVENUE FROM WHERE IT ENTERS MIAMI SPRINGS TO
HUNTING LODGE DRIVE AS "FATHER CARNEY WAY"

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2013 the Mayor and City Council of the City of Miami Springs adopted Resolution No. 2013-3589, which codesignated that portion of NW 59th Avenue from where it enters Miami Springs to Hunting Lodge Drive as "Father Carney Way," in recognition of the contributions of Father Carney to the City of Miami Springs, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Father Joseph Carney was ordained at St. Mary's Cathedral in 1968 by Miami's first archbishop, Coleman F. Carroll; and

WHEREAS, after his ordination, Father Carney served as parochial vicar at Nativity in Hollywood, Our Lady Queen of Martyrs, and St. John the Baptist in Fort Lauderdale, Little Flower in Coral Gables, and Our Lady of the Lakes in Miami Lakes, before being appointed pastor of Blessed Trinity Church in the Village of Virginia Gardens in 1982; and

WHEREAS, Father Carney continued to serve Blessed Trinity and the surrounding community until his death on January 2, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Father Carney also served on the Archdiocesan Permanent Diaconate Review Board from 1986 to 1993 and as an elected member of the Presbyteral Council from 1995 to 2010; and

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 59th Avenue from where it enters Miami Springs to Hunting Lodge Drive is a city street located in the City of Miami Springs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Springs wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami Springs codesignation of that portion of NW 59th Avenue from where it enters Miami Springs to Hunting Lodge Drive as "Father Carney Way."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor of the City of Miami Springs, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami Springs Police Department and the Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-3589

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE CO-DESIGNATION OF THE PORTION OF N. W. 59TH AVENUE FROM WHERE IT ENTERS MIAMI SPRINGS TO HUNTING LODGE DRIVE AS "FATHER CARNEY WAY"; REQUESTING AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PLACEMENT OF PROPER RECOGNITION SIGNAGE; EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Father Joseph Carney was the Pastor at Blessed Trinity Church in the Village of Virginia Gardens for thirty years who had a significant impact on the lives of many residents in the City of Miami Springs; and,

WHEREAS, upon the occasion of his death, the City Memorial Committee and the City Council have determined that it is both proper and appropriate to memorialize his contributions to the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has authorized the City Manager to request that Miami-Dade County co-designate the portion of N. W. 59th Avenue from where it enters Miami Springs to Hunting Lodge Drive as "Father Carney Way":

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Miami Springs hereby requests that Miami-Dade County approve and authorize the official co-designation of that portion of N. W. 59th Avenue from where it enters Miami Springs to Hunting Lodge Drive as "Father Carney Way".

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Miami Springs hereby further requests that Miami-Dade County approve and authorize the placement of appropriate signage along this roadway area to properly notify all persons of the official recognition and co-designation of "Father Carney Way".

Section 3: That the provisions of this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption by the City Council.






