



ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 33-1(79) OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA PERTAINING TO NUMBER OF PIGEONS THAT MAY BE KEPT IN NONCOMMERCIAL PIGEON LOFTS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 33-1(79) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

(79) *Pigeon loft, noncommercial.* The maintenance of not more than ~~[[twenty (20)]]~~ >>ten (10)<< carrier or racing pigeons for the purposes of engaging in the hobby of racing pigeons for sport.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

¹ Words stricken through and/or ~~[[double bracketed]]~~ shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
