

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-503 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, the Miami-Dade Economic Advocacy Trust Nominating Council ("Nominating Council") convened to solicit, screen, and interview perspective applicants for the Miami-Dade Economic Advocacy Trust ("Trust") Board of Trustees ("Trustees"); and

WHEREAS, the pursuant to Section 2-503 and the procedures adopted by this Board on December 16, 2008, the Nominating Council solicited, screened and interviewed perspective applicants; and

WHEREAS, there are presently five (5) Trust vacancies; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2013, the Nominating Council concluded its final interviews and voted unanimously to recommend to the Board a slate of five (5) nominees to fill the vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the nominees resumes or biographical information are attached hereto for the Board's consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Nominating Council also finds that each of the nominees meet and/or exceed the minimum qualifications set forth in Section 2-503(b) and (c), and Section 2-11.38 of the Code of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Nominating Council recommends the following nominees for approval by the Board: (a) Sheldon L. Edwards, whose professional expertise is in banking and finance; (b) LaTonda James, whose professional expertise is in housing; (c) Carl Nicoleau, whose professional expertise is in educational organization; (d) Cornell Crews, Jr. whose professional expertise is in economic and business development; and (e) Cheryl Mizell, whose professional expertise is in economic and business development,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:
