Subject: Resolution Requesting Authority to Exercise Option-to-Renew Period Under Existing Contract

Agenda Item No. 8(F)(7)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) delegate to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee the authority to exercise, in their discretion, the option-to-renew (OTR) set forth in this item. Ordinance No. 07-139 provides for committee review exemption.

The OTR being considered by the Board in this item is described briefly below and in more detail in the accompanying attachment:

Item 1 – Fence Materials - Prequalification: Seeks authority to exercise the sole, five-year OTR term for fence materials, estimated at \$800,000. Approval of this item will extend the prequalification pool contract until March 31, 2019.

Scope

The impact of the item in the accompanying OTR package is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

Contract amounts and department allocations represent the maximum spending authority based on estimated past usage. This action does not guarantee that the total contract amounts/values will be expended by these County departments and/or agencies. Funding will be expended only if departmental budgets can support the expenditures as approved in their annual budget adopted by the Board.

Track Record/Monitor

There are no known performance issues with the vendors recommended for award. The departments' contract managers are reflected in the attached OTR package.

Delegated Authority

If this item is approved, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise the OTR in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract listed in the accompanying package.

Background

The contract listed in this item require approval to exercise the sole OTR. The contract were awarded under the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee's delegated authority pursuant to Section 2-8.1(b) of the County Code and the Master Procurement Implementing Order, I.O. 3-38.

The contract in this package was awarded prior to the effective date of Ordinance 09-52, which requires obtaining Board authorization to award contracts where the renewal options would bring the cumulative value of the contract above \$1 million.

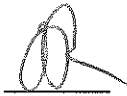

JUSTIFICATION:

This pool of pre-qualified vendors has been established to purchase fence materials, such as chain link, wood, aluminum, steel, galvanized steel and aluminum picket and automated gates, on an as-needed basis. The materials are used to maintain existing fences at various County facilities. Materials are purchased through spot market competitions and additional qualified vendors may be added at any time during the contract term. This method of award ensures that the County receives the best available pricing at the time the department requires fence material.

The allocations for Public Works and Waste Management as well as Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces include \$120,000 and \$200,000, respectively, for hurricane-related emergencies.
